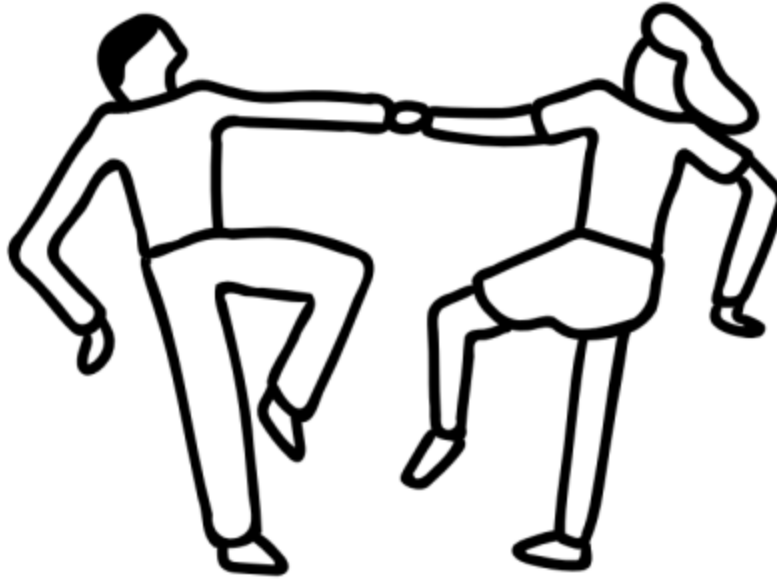

AFTER SCHOOL AND EVENING SOCIAL ACTIVITY RULES

The school sponsors activities such as dances, socials, intramurals and clubs as part of the educational program at John Read Middle School. In order to establish and maintain a positive atmosphere at these social affairs, we ask for your cooperation in observing the following rules:

Attendance is limited to John Read Middle School students only.

As this is a school function, all school rules apply.

Although students may need cell phones for parent contact after the event, devices are not to be used during the event. Students who violate this rule will have their device confiscated and may receive further disciplinary consequences.

No student may attend the social or evening school activity unless they have been in school that day for a minimum of three hours.

Students must arrive within 15 minutes of the start of activity and plan to stay until the end. No one is permitted to leave the building and/or area of the activity.

Decorations may not be removed by students even at the end of the activity. The custodians or an assigned clean-up crew will remove all decorations.

Parents are requested to pick their children up immediately following the completion of the activity. Students should not have to wait more than five (5) minutes for a ride home.
