FROM THE PRECENTOR

Anglican Missions Board is an office of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa, New Zealand and Polynesia. Their task is to foster partnership with churches overseas. At the request of a partner from overseas, a certain project or ministry is supported. During the Lenten appeal this year we, the Cathedral community, supported the work of Sisters of the Church, an Anglican religious order of sisters, in their Christian Care Centre in the Solomon Islands. These sisters care for women and children who are victims of family violence.

As a default, the Cathedral community contributes \$2,400 each year to the work of Anglican missions. This year, for the first time, we have pledged our contribution for a concrete project: help in resettlement of the landless people in Nadawa, Fiji. Buying plots of land will offer security and independence to a group of 12 Melanesian families, who would otherwise be without their own section of land.

Now it is time for the Spring appeal. Would you like to support a Diocesan Boys' Hostel in Pakistan, a Mission Partner in Papua New Guinea, or a medical clinic in Togo Africa? Now is the time. Please see the poster in the visitor centre and, in coming months, if you wish, support one of those projects. The easiest way is to place your gift in an ordinary envelope, seal it and write on it "Anglican Missions" for (choose the project). This is one of the most practical and visible ways of support to the missions.
