FROM THE DEAN

As was indicated in the newsletter last Sunday there will be some video filming occurring in the Cathedral during the 10am service on the 6th August. This video project is part of the Consecration planning and is aimed at the general visitor to the cathedral, from secondary school student to tourist. It will be both a promotional video and an information/educational video of about 15 minutes long. It will focus on the buildings: why they look like they do and what happens in them.

Interviews will occur with:

Bishop Ross on why it's called a cathedral, bishop's seat, what makes a cathedral different from a parish church, three-tikanga structure of Anglican Church in NZ.

Prof Peter Lineham, historian, on form and history of this particular building. Brief reference to St Mary's being moved across Parnell Rd – most focus on main HTC structure

Robert Ellis, artist, on Maori motifs and local references in design of own work and those of other stained-glass artists.

Dean Anne Mills, in Selwyn Chapel, on newest part of HTC and how the chapel provides connection to the world outside: metaphor for what the cathedral does.

As well as with the music staff; Michael and Philip.

The congregation filming will provide fly-on-the-wall coverage.

This will be a wonderful resource for us at the Cathedral to have and we are most grateful to Dawn Jones and Paul Bushnell for their time and expertise in organising and bringing to fruition this project.
