The Eureka Fire Protection District is an expanding department, which has many demands, put on us. We would like, very much, to have interested people involved in helping us to provide the services to the community, and hopefully, you could be a part of our organization.

We request a lot from our members, and therefore, we try to give them as much as we possibly can. We will provide the best possible training and equipment that we have available to us and strive to improve at all times. The fire service is a field, which is constantly changing, and the need for training is very important.

We hope you will review this packet and ask any and all, questions which you have before making your decision. We hope you decide that you would like to become a part of our organization.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1.) Attend a minimum of 12 hours of District approved training per quarter. Training is held the first Thursday evening and last Saturday of each month. We expect you to be able to respond to at least 1/3 of the SAR callouts.
- 2.) Furnish your own team uniform and related SAR equipment at your expense.
- 3.) Obtain and maintain certifications required for membership.
- 4.) Adhere to team guidelines as outlined in the SAR Team Standard Operating Guidelines.

NOTE: Failure to meet these requirements for one quarter is ground for removal from the staff.

If you are accepted you will need to present copies of the following:

Drivers license

Social Security Card

Any SAR related certifications (canine also, if canine handler)

Any professional licenses

All current EMS cards

Any other Fire / EMS certifications
