

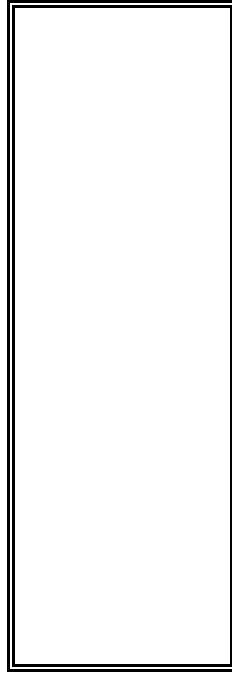

**RALLY PAIRS NOVICE** - For two dogs working together and handled by one handler. An Official AKC Entry Form must be completed in full for each dog. Please send Pairs entry forms together.

**RALLY TEAM NOVICE** - The Team class will be for teams of any four dogs with four handlers. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required. A separate Official AKC Entry Form must be completed in full for each dog entered (including the Alternate). No dog may be entered on more than one team. In addition to the Official AKC Entry Form for each dog, please complete the RALLY TEAM ENTRY FORM (on Page 7), indicating the dogs/handlers on the team, and optional Team Name. 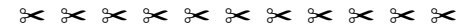

Set-up: Set-up will be in the parking lot. Limited shade. Handlers should bring crate covers to protect your dogs. There is no set-up in the building.

Directions: Heading Northbound on I-680 from San Ramon or Highway 24 from Orinda:

- I-680 and Highway 24 merge together at Walnut Creek
- Continue heading North on I-680
- Take exit 49B for Monument Blvd
- Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Monument Blvd and merge onto Monument Blvd
- Go 1.7 miles
- Turn right onto Detroit Ave
- Go 0.4 miles.
- MDDTC is on your right (1027-A Detroit Ave, Concord, CA 94518)
  - West side of Detroit Ave, after the Gingnam Café and before Rachel Dunn Chocolates and across from the PG&E maintenance yard.

No provisions are made for unentered dogs. No unentered dogs will be allowed within the Trial Limits, defined as within the MDDTC Training Building.

1. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged in the ring.
2. Use only the designated dog potty area.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. To be acceptable, an entry must be submitted with the required entry fee on an official American Kennel Club entry form, or a photocopy of the official AKC entry form. THE AGREEMENT AND RULES MUST BE PRINTED ALONGSIDE OR ON THE REVERSE.
2. **PLEASE TYPEWRITE OR NEATLY PRINT ALL ENTRIES.** Please use black or blue ink when writing entries. The Club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
3. Entries without fees cannot be accepted. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
4. Unsigned, incomplete, or telephone entries will not be accepted. Faxed and emailed entries are allowed, with fees paid via PayPal. See instructions on Page 2.
5. The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
6. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT** of entries will be made soon after the closing date. Should such acknowledgement not be received by an exhibitor seven (7) days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
7. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged. We suggest dogs be present one hour before scheduled time of judging.
8. Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.
9. The Management will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the Club nor the management will be responsible for loss or injury.
10. Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
11. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the Trial grounds or premises.
12. In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.
13. No special award will be mailed or delivered. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for a special award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award for him.
14. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
15. **MOVE-UPS** (Class Transfers) will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 15 of the AKC Rally Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes prior to judging.
16. **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).

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- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
