47. HANDLING (2.13)(a)(1) HANDLING OF ALL ANIMALS SHALL BE DONE IN A MANNER THAT DOES NOT CAUSE TRAUMA, OVERHEATING, BEHAVIORAL STRESS, PHYSICAL HARM OR UNNECESSARY DISCOMFORT. THE FOLLOWING TWO INCIDENTS WERE DESCRIBED IN NMES/NECESSARY REPORTS.

- TRAINING AREA: PLANNED FACILITY

① THREE CALIFORNIA SEA LIONS WERE LEFT WITHOUT WATER FOR APPROXIMATELY 2 HOURS DURING TANK CLEANING (30 OCT 1992). ONE FEMALE, "HONEY HOPE," DIED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THIS OCCURRENCE. CAUSE OF DEATH WAS NOTED AS HEAT EXHAUSTION.

- DOLPHIN "KENNEL" - "D" TANK

② FIVE DOLPHINS WERE LEFT STRANDED WHEN A DRAIN WAS ACCIDENTALLY LEFT OPEN WITHOUT SUPERVISION. ONE FEMALE TURSIOPS TRUNCATUS FULLI, "KAULA", DIED ON 27 MAY 1991 FOLLOWING THIS INCIDENT, WHICH OCCURRED 23 MAY 1991. NECROPSY/PATHOLOGY REPORTS INDICATE SUPERFICIAL CUTS AND ABRASIONS ON VENTRAL SURFACE AND PECTORAL FINS, PSEUDOMONAS PUTRESCENS (4/11/91) PNEUMONIA, AND SEVERE PULMONARY HEMORRHAGE AND NECROSIS [SHE HAD BEEN TREATED WITH CEFAL 5/6/91 THROUGH 5/15/91]

NONCOMPLIANCES HAVE APPARENTLY BEEN CORRECTED (NOTE DATES OF ORIGINAL INCIDENT 1/10/94). TANK DRAINING IS NOW SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES AND ANIMALS HAVE NOT BEEN LEFT WITHOUT WATER DURING TANK CLEANING SINCE THE ABOVE SEA LION INCIDENT.
