Millennial Nuclear Caucus Slated for AR Summit V @ Texas A&M

The Millennials for Nuclear and the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Nuclear Energy will hold a "Millennial Nuclear Caucus" as part of the Advanced Reactors Summit V and Technology Trailblazers Showcase at Texas A&M on February 20-22, 2018.

The interactive webcast Caucus conversation on advanced technology and the future will be a highlight of a Career Fair on February 20 with 100 elite undergraduate and graduate Texas A&M Department of Nuclear Energy students featuring leading nuclear energy companies, organizations and National Laboratories. Texas A&M boasts the nation's largest Nuclear Engineering program with a current enrollment of 450 undergraduate and graduate students.

The Millennial Nuclear Caucus was initiated as part of the October 16-20 Nuclear Science Week and included a meeting with U.S. Energy Secretary Rick Perry as well as a colloquy on "human capital and nuclear energy" sponsored by the Millennials for Nuclear.

The Summit V & Showcase is the largest cross-cutting technology gathering of the Advanced Reactor community in the United States with more than 400 participants expected for its array of events, which will include an Awards Reception at the George Bush Library on February 21, a Career Fair with Texas A&M nuclear engineering students on February 20 with a welcome reception at the Legacy Club at Kyle Field and a Technology Trailblazer Showcase at the Summit. The Summit plenary sessions will be held at the new Stella Hotel adjacent to the Texas A&M campus. The proceedings include overarching technical issues as well as Advanced Reactors licensing, infrastructure and commercialization in addition to the featured technology developers.
