Hello to everybody,

We are very proud to announce an european teaching day on the 124. Congress of the German Society of Physical and Rehabilitation medicine.

The congress takes place in Munich, Germany, Sept 12th until Sept 14th 2019.

Main language is german.

However, in order to extend international relationships and to strengthen the identity of PRM-specialists we've planned a separate international day in english.

It takes place on sept14th with a main topic: Management of Complex Regional Pain Syndrome.

For this purpose, international experts will:

- inform us about the latest evidence about CPRS**
- teach us skills in the management of CRPS.**

How is the schedule?

The day starts at 8:30 with a key-lecture "PRM International trends" with the main goal to imagine the role and the standing of PRM in other countries. Therefor Prof. Piravey (Bangkok, Thailand) and Prof. Thevenon (Lille, France) are presenting the perspectives of their country.

Afterwards, the main teaching program is starting at 10.30am to 3.00pm with international speakers.

Who are the speakers ?

All speakers are established experts on the field of CRPS.

Speakers and topics (topics may change a little bit to the final version):

- 1) Pathophysiology and Neuroplasticity in CRPS (Eduard Kraft, Munich, Germany)
- 2) Clinical Phenomenology of CRPS (Anselm Reiners, Munich, Germany)
- 3) Management of CRPS - (Roberto Casale, Brescia, Italy)
- 4) Cognitive Therapies in CRPS (Candy McCabe, Bath, UK)
- 5) Interventional Pain Procedures in CRPS (Shahnaz Azad, Munich, Germany)

What are we doing after the session?

Afterwards it's time to check the city. We can get to know each other and share international experiences. Furthermore, we can talk about all the great knowledge about CRPS that we've earned.

A city trip (sight seeing) will be organized and afterwards we can meet in a bar/pub.

How much do I pay for it?

If you are currently a resident of PRM the whole teaching program is for free, including a lunch-buffet and drinks.

Furthermore we have organized free accommodations (Hostel, limited amount!).

This relates **only to the night Friday Sept 13th to Saturday Sept 14th.**

As soon as we have your registration, you'll get more information.

The journey to Munich should be organized by yourself.

City trip and pub-reservations will be organized by us, but have to be paid if you are participating. We will also inform you about details as soon as possible.
