


The State of South Dakota compiles data on school district expenditures and ranks districts based on the amount of money it costs to educate a student in a given district. In the 2015-16 school year, it cost \$7,189 to educate a student in the West Central School District. This ranks West Central 138 out of 150 districts, indicating the district spent less money per student than all but 12 districts in the state of South Dakota.
