#### ***Camp Information:***

The 2019 Summer STEAM Camp (TSSC) will be facilitated by Global Health Connections International on the campus on North Carolina Central University. We are in the fifth year of *Making Differences in Lives* of middle school and university students.

We are excited about outreach into the following North Carolina counties: Durham, Edgecombe, Franklin, Granville, Guilford, Halifax, Martin, Nash, Person, Robeson, Vance, Wake, Warren, and Wilson Counties.

Campers will participate in interactive, inquiry-based classes taught by professors, certified secondary school teachers, and STEAM professionals. The hallmark tenet of our 2019 camp will be a STEAM based triadic learning framework:

1. Shadowing and modeling medical and dental school students
2. Collegiate collaborative circuit tours to North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University School of Agriculture, The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill School of Medicine and School of Dentistry, North Carolina State University School of Engineering and North Carolina Central University FABLAB and Biomanufacturing Research Institute and Technology Enterprise (BRITE)
3. Classroom interactive engagement featuring coding, entrepreneurship, and entertainment

The camp promotes science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) education. In North Carolina, we know that traditionally underserved and underrepresented students have limited opportunities for summer educational enrichment. Thus, all students who are selected will have the opportunity to attend the 2-week residential camp free of charge. Any students currently in the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, or 7<sup>th</sup> grade, who has an interest in science, technology, arts, and mathematics is our focus.

Student must have at least a B average in science and mathematics courses and a passing score on the state’s standardized science and mathematics tests is eligible to apply. **Parents, please understand that your child MUST have the desire to attend the camp.** Immediate family members of GHCI and staff are not eligible.

TSSC is a 2-week, academic, residential camp that emphasizes increasing students’ mathematics and science knowledge and skills. We will be introducing campers to college life and stimulating their interests in science, technology, engineering, arts and math as potential career paths.



## ***2019 SUMMER STEAM CAMP INFORMATION***

The camp will be held on the campus of North Carolina Central University 1801 Fayetteville St., Durham, NC 27707

- 48 campers will reside in one of the beautiful on-campus Residence Halls
- Camp participants will be selected from Durham, Edgecombe, Franklin, Granville, Guilford, Halifax, Martin, Nash, Person, Robeson, Vance, Wake, Warren, and Wilson Counties.

- Parent/Guardian and student complete requested information on the **Student Application Form** (pages 3-5)
- Parent/Guardian request **student records** from the student's school registrar (page 6).
- Parent/Guardian or student gives recommendation form to the student's current **Science teacher** (page 7) and current **Mathematics teacher** (page 8).
- Student writes a **250-word essay**. Instructions for the essay are on page 9.
