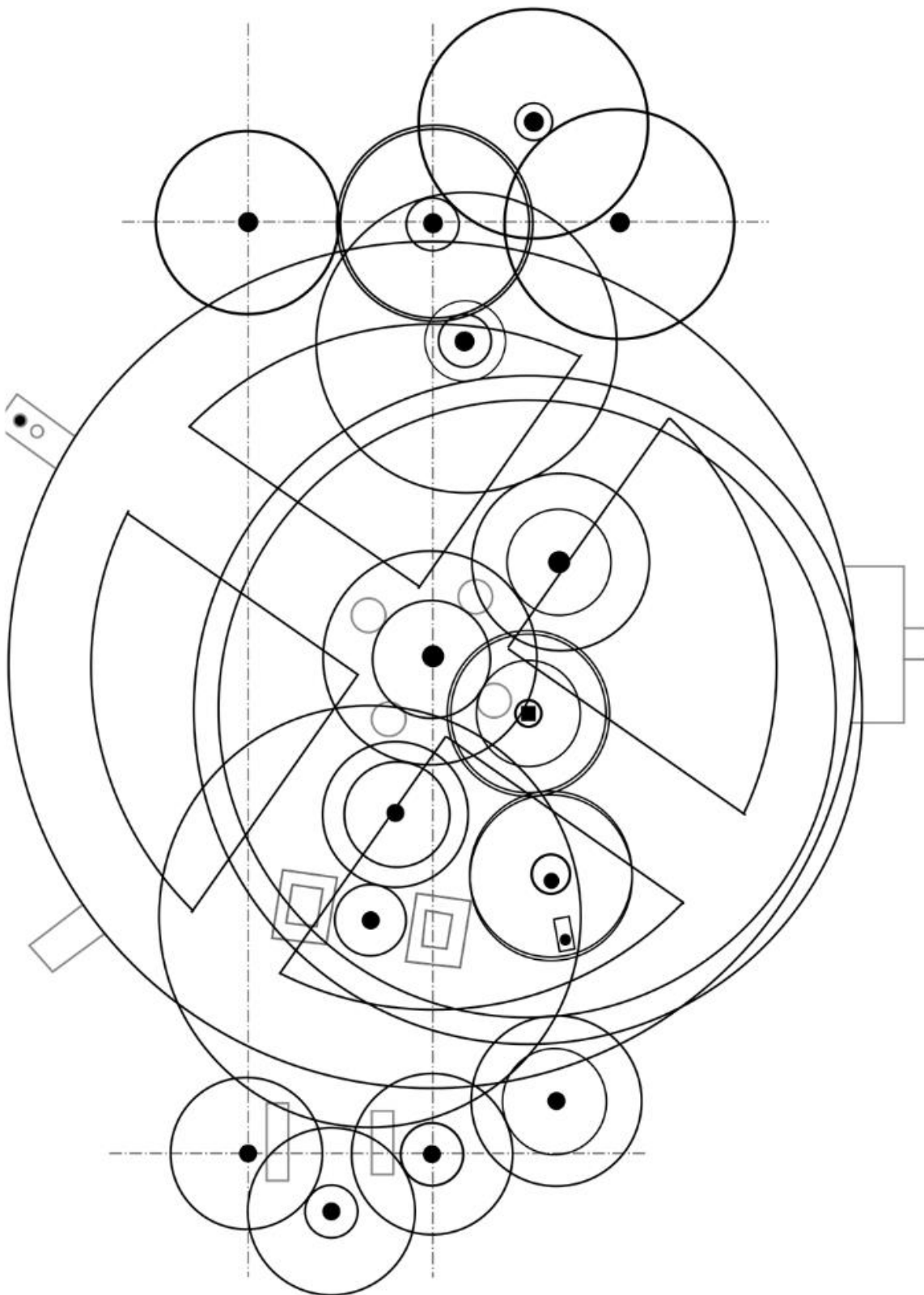


Antikythera Mechanism: Schematic
