



Master Guides Recertification Program

(Continued Education)

Recertification of Master Guides in the North American Division will take place every three years. In order to obtain recertification you must:

1. Provide a record of service for each year during the three year period (signed by the Area Coordinator).
2. Attend a two hour seminar on each of the following topics:
 - a. Redefining Leadership
 - b. Human Relations & Conflict Resolution
 - c. Current Issues
 - d. Child Protection
 - e. Risk Management
 - f. Disaster Preparedness

If you have been inactive for five (5) or more years you need to complete the Basic Staff Training Course, along with the seminars listed above.

Master Guides from other Divisions/Conferences and/or Countries

Master Guides coming from other Divisions/Conferences and/or Countries who would like to become active in the North American Division must present one of the following as well as complete the recertification program:

- A letter of investiture from their conference and/or mission.
- Proof of Investiture. For example: certificate, pictures, etc.
