



## Uniform Inspection Process

Master Guides will be in Class A uniform in the designated area for inspection. The DIRECTOR or DRILL MASTER need to follow the uniform inspection form to be sure that all the elements are in place.

The INSPECTOR will walk to the front of the Club and announce that he/she is ready to take the uniform inspection.

The DIRECTOR or DRILL MASTER will call the Master Guides to FALL IN, OPEN RANKS and stand in ATTENTION. Note: It may be necessary to remain in the same place and not OPEN RANKS if there is no room to do so.

The DIRECTOR or DRILL MASTER will walk to the INSPECTOR, stop and stand in attention, and then do a present arms to the INSPECTOR.

The INSPECTOR will stand in attention, and do a present arms to the DIRECTOR and will ask "DIRECTOR, is your club ready for uniform inspection?"

The DIRECTOR or DRILL MASTER will respond with "Yes, the club is ready for uniform Inspection".

The INSPECTOR will ask and confirm the Church Name, Club Name, Camp site number and DIRECTOR Name

The DIRECTOR or DRILL MASTER will ask for the names of the INSPECTORS and make sure that is noted in the form.

The INSPECTOR will ask if there are any comments before the Inspection.

The DIRECTOR or DRILL MASTER will provide those comments like I have 2 members that are new and they are dress in black and white, etcetera.

The INSPECTOR will write the comments in the form and proceed with the inspection.

Once the inspection is completed the INSTRUCTOR will notify the DIRECTOR of the result, and will give the DIRECTOR a copy of the inspection.

The DIRECTOR will stand in attention, and then do a present arms to the INSPECTOR.

The INSPECTOR will stand in attention, and do present arms to the DIRECTOR and will say "DIRECTOR, thank you for your time and have a good day."

The INSPECTOR will exit the area.
