Miriam Wolfe Memorial Scholarship 2019 Application Instructions

Three scholarships will be awarded: a \$1,500 one-time scholarship, a \$1,000 one-time scholarship, and a \$1,000 one-time 2019 commemorative scholarship honoring the 30-year anniversary of the awards inception. In the case of a point tie, the funds will be equally divided, and each awardee will receive a \$1,167 one-time scholarship.

The Applicant must:

1. Be a high school senior.
2. Have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
3. Be a current member of Children's Theatre of Annapolis (CTA). If you are not a current member of CTA, please contact the office at 410-757-2281 to pay the \$20.00 membership fee prior to submitting your application.
4. Plan to pursue *an interest* in performing arts at the college level. This includes both artistic and technical aspects of the performing arts. Please note: *This scholarship does not require the applicant to major in the performing arts in order to be eligible.*
5. Complete the application according to directions, including the required essay questions. The use of additional pages or a chart format are accepted and can be attached to the application. Do NOT include personal resumes.
6. Provide one (1) letter of recommendation from an adult individual *associated with the performing arts*. The recommendation CANNOT be from a relative of the applicant.
7. Submit the completed application, essays, and letter of recommendation electronically to ctascholarship@gmail.com no later than 11:59 p.m. on May 1, 2019.

Please note: To qualify for consideration of this scholarship, all criteria above must be met, and the information provided on the application must be complete. This includes the verified GPA and a signature from a school counselor OR a current official transcript.

By submitting this application, the applicant acknowledges that he/she is no longer eligible to participate in CTA productions as a student performer as of the end of the current school year.

The scholarship committee chair will receive the applications and distribute them to outside panelists for scoring. Completed evaluations from the panelists will be returned for review by the scholarship committee then sent to the Executive Board for final concurrence. Award recipients will be notified in advance of the awards ceremony on Friday, May 17, at 7p.m.

Scholarship checks and books signed by Miriam Wolfe's mother, Rosemary Mild will be presented to the award recipients during intermission at the May 17th, 7 p.m. performance of Chitty Chitty Bang Bang JR. ALL CTA SENIORS WILL BE RECOGNIZED at the ceremony and will receive four complimentary tickets to attend the show with their family.
