### **What Are Cookies?**

### **IP Addresses**

IP addresses are used by your computer every time you are connected to the Internet. Your IP address is a number that is used by computers on the network to identify your computer. IP addresses are automatically collected by our web-server as part of demographic and profile data known as "traffic data" so that data (such as the webpages you request) can be sent to you.

### **Email Information**
