Instructor Bios

Keri Duke: Keri is the mother of five and grandmother to nine of the “brightest and cutest grandchildren in the world”. She has a degree in Special Education and Fashion Technology. In 1991, she began a fashion career designing wedding gowns for a renowned Japanese bridal company and couture children’s clothing. In 1998, Keri designed the stained glass windows based on Hawaiian flowers and quilting patterns for the Kahalia Aloha Wedding chapel in Maui. Her island home in Hawaii provides her with an amazing source of inspiration and quilting allows her to express this inspiration. Keri credits her husband, Lloyd, a plant ecologist for Haleakala National Park, for teaching her the beauty of the Hawaiian plants and most of her inspiration comes from nature. In 2001, Keri started a quilting business based on Hawaiian flora. Additionally, Keri recently obtained exclusive permission from the estate of mid-century modern artist Charley Harper to interpret his art into quilts and quilt patterns. Combining her love of Hawaii and passion for needle arts makes Keri one of the most inspiring instructors for needle turn appliqué as well as other forms of needle art and we are delighted to have her join us on this exciting adventure. Pat Krasnoz: Pat began sewing at the age of 6, taught by her mother who was a professional seamstress trained in Germany. When her own daughter showed an interest in learning to sew and wanted to include her friends as well, Pat bought several sewing machines and began teaching the children to sew and quilt in a small room in her home. This continued for many years and eventually Pat and her husband, Bill, remodeled their home and opened a quilt shop/sewing school that continued for the next 18 years with classes also including adults. Due to relocation to Calgary, Pat had to close the shop that was dear to her but now works in one of the largest fabric shops in Calgary. She teaches for guilds and at weekend retreats and will soon begin teaching at the shop where she works. Pat has been sailing on Quilt Camp at Sea cruises since 2010 and she is very excited at the opportunity to teach on several upcoming cruises.

Carol Porter: Carol is the Education Director for Clover Needlecraft where she helps make the company’s many unique products accessible and engaging. She is an accomplished author, designer, sewer, quilter, knitter, pattern maker, and crafter. Carol is also a disciplined and thoughtful teacher whose encouragement and patience regularly inspires student creativity and success. Carol is recognized for the strength of her “colorwash” designs and has produced quilt patterns under the Heatherworks label. Dodi started quilting over 30 years ago, while in college, when she needed a textile project. She taught herself to quilt and it has become her passion. She enjoys teaching the art of quilting and for nearly 30 years she has shared this with her students throughout the county. Dodi is the author of 5 books and over 70 published patterns. In 2006 she launched her pattern company, *Two Sisters at Squirrel Hollow* and later added a children’s division, *Little Londyn*, which she runs with her daughter, Megan Miles. Today she is happy to be designing and creating quilts at home in the state Washington. America Line. At its helm will be Captain Emiel de Vries, previously master of the ms. Amsterdam, ms. Eurodam, ms. Nieuw Amsterdam, ms. Rotterdam, and the ms. Zuiderdam. De Vries currently lives near Venice, Italy, to be close to the Fincantieri shipyard. He has been involved with the new-build project since 2014 and participated in the functional design of the navigation bridge (his “office” while onboard). Hailing from the Netherlands, de Vries grew up just east of Amsterdam and graduated from the Hogere Zeevaart School in Amsterdam, one of the oldest nautical schools in the world, with degrees in navigation and engineering and began his career with Holland America Line in 1995. When not in Italy, de Vries lives in Barrie, Ontario, Canada with his wife, Susan, and their daughter.

Guests onboard will have the opportunity to enjoy fine dining in several alternative restaurants include Sel de Mer, a new French seafood brasserie; a new immersive farm-to-table dinner experience in the Culinary Arts Center presented by Food & Wine magazine; a re-designed casual Lido Market with themed serving stations; a stunning main dining room; and favorites such as the Pinnacle Grill, Canaletto Italian restaurant, and pan-Asian tamarind.

Onboard entertainment will be taken to a new level with the energetic Music Walk area featuring all genres of music showcased in venues including Lincoln Center Stage offering chamber music nightly; Billboard Onboard where live musicians rock the crowd with chart-topping hits; and the popular B.B. King’s Blues Club in the Queen’s Lounge bringing the best of Memphis music to sea. World Stage brings 270-degree LED projection to the main showroom, enabling new concepts for showtime performances and immersing the audience in a panorama or sight and sound.

To bring this new ship to life, Holland America Line commissioned Adam Tihany, regarded as one of the world’s pre-eminent hospitality designers, and Bjorn Storbraaten, designer and architect. Together, they have designed light filled spaces, fluid curves, and a sophisticated interplay of high technology and elegance – with beautiful architectural elements inspired by music, all woven together in a forward thinking design approach. Even some of the decks have been named for inspiring composers –Schubert, Gershwin, Mozart, and Beethoven! Tihany says the key to his concept was an idea to tell a story that guests can connect with throughout their voyage – the thought of what you might see from inside of a musical instrument, what the architecture of the surfaces and geometry look like - a concept of utilizing visual interaction, where guests actively engage with the architecture rather than passively moving through it. “The design isn’t a literal translation of music but a conceptual approach where we seek to evoke the feeling and beauty of an instrument.”

Other design elements of this beautiful new class of ship include the central pool area’s Magrodome, which typically is a single level on most Holland America Line ships has been expanded to two levels to create a vast glass enclosed space. At the heart of the ship, Koningsdam’s central atrium is pure visual drama – soaring three decks high the space is graced by an airy stainless steel sculpture that evokes the feeling of a classical quartet with strings, arches, and bows. Like music itself, it changes as you move around it so that no two perspectives are quite the same. The atrium is capped by a ceiling that serves as a backdrop for subtly changing high-definition projections. Look up by day to see wispy cirrus clouds floating overhead or perhaps soothing colors of water and light. By evening, the atrium takes dramatic lighting hues or reflects the clear constellations of the night sky. **We look forward to welcoming you onboard.....**

Quilters Class Information

PLEASE note some of the classes are offered more than once in order to provide you with the opportunity to take most of the classes available. When you fill out your class request form, be sure to indicate ALL of the classes you want to take and the quilting coordinator will make every effort possible to provide you with a schedule that doesn't cause a conflict between the classes you want to take. HOWEVER, classes WILL BE FILLED on a first come/first served basis when the \$25 nonrefundable deposit required for EACH class is received. This deposit will be credited as a payment from your total class fee but it will be forfeited if you cancel the class or the cruise. A class request form is located at the back of this packet and you do have the option of using a credit card for payment. **As always on Quilt Camp at Sea cruises, complete pre-cut class kits will be provided by the instructors. A small non-refundable deposit to confirm your space in each class will be required. A supply list of other supplies you will need for class will be provided but will be kept to a minimum.....**

Many of the class projects for this cruise will not feature a photograph because they have been designed EXCLUSIVELY for this cruise! During our days at sea, we will have coffee, tea, iced water, and snacks available FOR THE QUILTERS in the Half Moon I room on main deck from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Class Descriptions

Keri Duke – Needlepoint Evening bag This class includes a pre-finished black purse with a silk robe handle and a hand painted hibiscus on 14 count canvas. During class you will learn to needlepoint in six easy stitches using Perle cotton and silk ribbon with beaded accents. This is a 2-part class held in four hour sessions during the cruise. You may select your choice of red, yellow, or pink ribbon for your hibiscus.

Class/kit fee: \$225.00

Keri Duke – Cruise Souvenir Appliqué Come and learn needle turn appliqué on a tropical pillow or small wall hanging designed exclusively for this cruise. The design includes a sunset scene with hand-dyed and batik fabrics. Your kit will feature a pre-cut and partially basted design with threads and batting.

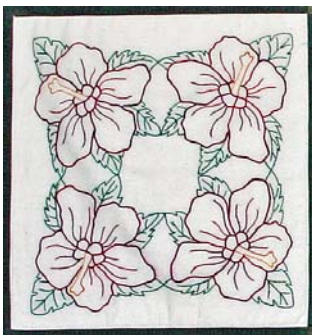
Class/kit fee: \$160.00

Keri Duke – Tropical Cross Stitch This is a fun and quick 2 session class to create a small ornament or wall hanging using beautiful hand dyed threads! Your kit includes 12 count Aida cloth or 22 count Luguana, color pattern of your pattern choice, hand-dyed threads, and needle with enough materials to finish as an ornament 3 ½ inch square.

Class/kit fee: \$65.00

Keri Duke – Tropical Threads (or as our quilting coordinator refers to it “Redwork Gone Tropical!!”). The completed block made with hand dyed floss can easily be incorporated into a quilt or made into a pillow after the cruise. What a beautiful memento of your cruise this will be!! This is a two session class.

Pat Krasnozou: *Hand Embroidered Sewing Set* This class features an embroidered and embellished sewing set (scissor fob, needle holder, and scissor holder) featuring wool felt and designed exclusively for this cruise. This is a really fun 4 hour class that you will be VERY sorry if you miss it..... **Class/kit fee: \$100.00**

Carol Porter: *Woven Fabric Basket* Create your own fabric basket from unique Batik fabrics during this four hour class. The stunning Caribbean color palette of blues, greens, aquamarine waters, sunset pinks & reds and yellow-golden sunshine will be worked into your personally designed basket. Carol will share many techniques and tools to open your creative world as you travel through the ocean & islands. Kits will be prepared and cut for an immediate weaving lesson and basket construction.

Class/kit fee: \$120.00

Carol Porter: *English Paper Pieced Medallion* This one of a kind medallion will hold your cruise memories forever. Your finished piece can be worked into a quilt, a pillow top, or wall piece. This four hour class will be a great time to experience "EPP" as Carol shows you tricks of the art and shares how the designs work. This is NOT your average EPP!

Class/kit fee: \$120.00

Carol Porter: *Tropical Felting Wool on Wool* This class is a luscious twist on Felting Wool on Wool bringing new techniques and gorgeous tropical colors and images with a hint of primitive to boot!! Learn to enhance with embroidery stitches as you fall in love with your own embellishments. This is a two session class for a total of 5 hours during the cruise. The kit will be all inclusive – come ready for fun and meeting new friends!! **Class/kit fee: \$125.00**

Dodi Poulsen: *Colors of Paradise Embroidery* What's better than the beautiful colors of the Islands? Make this delightful handwork piece of island homes in beautiful tropical colors using wool felt. Using threads that will enhance these wonky houses you will explore new stitches with Dodi as you make the center of this piece of wall art or pillow. Fabrics to complete your piece will be provided. You can complete your project after your return from Paradise with a minimum of machine work. **Class/kit fee: \$115.00**

Dodi Poulsen: *Creative Island Stitching felted wool purse* Embellishing on wool is exciting and fun. Using wool in tropical colors & Sue Spargo's Creative Stitching book, we will learn fabulous stitches which will embellish a darling purse. We will also experiment with a bit of wool roving materials. (finished size approx. 11 x 14 finished with tortoise acrylic handles) Beautiful appliques will remind you of your island cruise. Kit will include wool, threads, Sue Spargo's Creative Stitching book (\$36.00 retail), handles, and all fabrics to complete your purse. A small bit of sewing will be required after returning from your cruise to assemble the purse. Come and explore the adventure of stitching in Paradise!

Class/kit fee: \$135.00

Dodi Poulsen: *Say Chicken!* Chicken? Chicken Scratch that is! What a fun and relaxing class this will be. Using the basic chicken scratch stitch Dodi will teach you how to maximize your efforts into a beautifully decorated full cotton canvas apron. Using pearle cotton threads in multiple colors you will create a design that anyone will be envious of. After learning this technique you will be able to decorate and embellish other items with this creative process. You will be amazed at the fabulous look that can be achieved with this traditional stitch, gone modern. **So, don't be a chicken, sign up for this hen party!!! Class/kit fee: \$95.00**

Dodi Poulsen: *Silk Ribbon Floral Embroidery class* With silk ribbons, we will transform fabric and ribbons into a stunning piece of art! Silk ribbon embroidery is exciting and creative.
