**Marcy was born in Groton, CT, while her Father, a U.S. Navy officer, was assigned to the U.S. Naval Submarine Base. She attended ten different schools, as the family was transferred all over the country by the Navy, before graduating from Ledyard High School in 1975. She received her Bachelor's Degree from the University of Virginia in 1979. In 1983 she married her former husband, who was a Navy officer stationed in Groton. Marcy attended law school at night while she was working full time as a Technical Writer/Editor at a military research and development company in Waterford, CT. She received her Juris Doctorate from the University of Connecticut School of Law in 1986.**

**After being admitted to the CT bar in 1986, Marcy worked as a Court Clerk for a year. In 1988 she was hired as a Deputy Assistant State's Attorney in New London, where she prosecuted many different types of cases, including narcotics trafficking, robberies, burglaries, DUI, assault, sexual assault, and child abuse. Her oldest two boys were born in 1991 and 1993. In 1994 the Navy sent the Pillsbury family to Norfolk, VA. They left Norfolk in 1997 for Naples, Italy, where Marcy's youngest son was born in 1999. The Pillsburys were transferred to Newport, RI, in 2000, where they spent the next seven years.**

**Marcy moved back to CT in 2007 and, in 2009, she was rehired as an Assistant State's Attorney in the Office of the Chief State's Attorney. She handled criminal appeals and habeas corpus proceedings, and also travelled to various offices around the state to assist with trials. Since early 2013 Marcy has been working in a partnership with the Connecticut Department of Labor to investigate and prosecute unemployment fraud. She is also currently working with the Division of Criminal Justice Cold Case Unit.**
