
Your Ramadan free gift from Muslim Children's Books

The Stories of the Prophets Game

You've read Migo & ALi: Love for the Prophets, Lots of times. Now you can see just how weLL you know the stories! Try easy, medium and difficult questions. The answers are given on each card and Migo is aLways there with his words of encouragement!



HOW TO PLAY

You'll find lots of ways to play games using these cards – use your imagination! Here's one way to do it:

2 pLayers

The players take it in turn to take a card from the stack and ask the other player which type of question they would like to answer (Giraffe, Bird, or Lion). If the player answers the question correctly, they get points according to below:

> Giraffe: 1 point Bird: 2 points Lion: 3 points

Important rule: Be fair! If there is a big age difference between the players, just give 1 point for every question, even if it's a Lion Question.

At the end, the person with most points wins!

3 or more players

Take it in turns to pick a card and ask the questions. When it's your turn, ask the Giraffe question on the card. The first of the other players to put their hand up is allowed to answer, for 1 point. If that person answers correctly, ask them the bird question, for 2 points. If they answer correctly, ask them the lion question, or 3 points. If they answered the first (giraffe) question incorrectly, ask all of the players bird question, but this time, the player that gave the wrong answer to the first question, is not allowed to answer. The first player to put their hand up can answer the question for 2 points. Now it's the next player's turn to take a card from the pack and ask the questions.

Read the other side too!

There are three types of questions on each card:



Giraffe - easy - true or false?

Bird – medium – fill in the blank.

Lion - difficult - open answer.

The answers for all of the questions on the cards can easily be found in the Migo & Ali: Love for the Prophets book. If you are finding it hard to answer a lot of the questions, have another read of the book and try again! You can be a lion!

For the lion questions, the player's words may be a bit different to those on the card. If what they have said has the same meaning, give them the point!
