Alabama	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Alaska	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Arizona	no	Will "NOT" accept any out of state learner's permit.
Arkansas	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
California	no	If you are a visitor in California, between 16 & 18 yrs old, you may drive here with your home state license or instruction permit for only 10 days after you arrive in California. After 10 days you must have either a Nonresident Minor's Certificate or a California License.
Colorado	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Connecticut	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Delaware	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
D.C. (Wash.)	no	A learner's permit issued by a jurisdiction other than the District of Columbia is "NOT" valid in the District of Columbia.
Florida	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Georgia	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Hawaii	no	Will "NOT" accept any out of state learner's permit.
Idaho	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Illinois	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Indiana	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Iowa	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Kansas	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Kentucky	no	The driver must be at least 16 yrs of age and restricted to no operation between the hours of 12 midnight & 6 AM
Louisiana	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Maine	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Maryland	no/yes	A learner's permit is allowed provided that the permit holder is at least 15 yrs + 9 months.
Massachusetts	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Michigan	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Minnesota	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.

Mississippi	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Missouri	no/yes	Must be at least 15 years and 182 days old. (15.5 yrs)
Montana	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Nebraska	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Nevada	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
New Hampshire	no	Will "NOT" accept any out of state learner's permit.
New Jersey	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
New Mexico	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
New York	no	An out-of-state learner's permit is "NOT" valid in New York City. You may not drive in New York State if you are under 16 - even if you are licensed in another state.
North Carolina	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
North Dakota	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Ohio	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Oklahoma	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Oregon	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Pennsylvania	no	Pennsylvania does "NOT" recognize an out-of-state beginner's permit.
Rhode Island	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
South Carolina	no	South Carolina does "NOT" recognize an out-of-state beginner's permit.
South Dakota	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Tennessee	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
Texas	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Utah	no	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state provided the person driving is at least 16 yrs of age.
Vermont	no	Vermont does "NOT" accept any out of state learner's permit.
Virginia	yes	Will accept any valid learner's permit subject to restrictions mandated by the issuing state.
