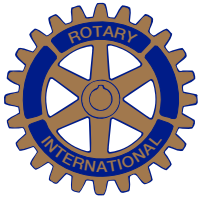

BCHG's mission is to ensure access to safe, affordable permanent housing for all members of our community.

BCHG operates 5 supportive family homeless shelter programs and provides rental subsidies to formerly homeless families. BCHG provides no-cost counseling for first-time homebuyers and foreclosure.

- 9 is the average age of a homeless person, a third grader



- 60% of our homeless clients are children.
- 487 people in Bucks County are homeless on any given night.
- BHG operates 3 food pantries located in Doylestown, Milford Square and Penndel. Last year 4,179 families were helped at our pantries.

HealthLink's mission is to provide preventative and restorative dental services and oral health education, to contribute to the overall health of low wage-earning adults in Bucks and Montgomery counties (earnings less than 250% of poverty level). Dental services include: oral exams, x-rays, fillings, dental hygiene, simple extractions, and patient education.

- HealthLink is a standalone clinic that is not affiliated with a hospital or healthcare system. The organization's budget is funded entirely by charitable contributions.
- During the third quarter of 2015 the clinic provided more than \$125,000 worth of dental services at no cost to the patient.
- Through September 2015, the clinic has already seen 937 patients and provided more than 1,300 dental appointments.
