**24 credit hours must be completed by end of April in order to apply for admission**, with no grade lower than 'C' in each of the required courses. ICM students must still complete the **30 credit hours of completed (passed) courses by end of August to be admitted.**

If a student has completed 24 to 60 credit hours of university work, the AGPA (Adjusted GPA) will be calculated using each grade earned at the post-secondary level – including repeated courses.
