## Scholarship Opportunities

Fall 2018

**4-H PEI Scholarships** have been established to provide support for 4-H members aspiring to further their education. 4-H PEI is pleased to offer several scholarships in 2019, recognizing both Grade 12 graduates AND students currently enrolled in/returning to a recognized, post-secondary school of learning.

### **Provincial Council Scholarship (\$1,000)**

- One Scholarship of \$1,000 awarded to a Grade 12 student

**\*\*Applicants are asked to prepare a 1000 word ESSAY on the following topic:**

*The key to the ongoing success of 4-H PEI as a youth development organization is to ensure it provides compelling and relevant programming to engage and educate its membership. **Please identify two challenges you see facing this task and provide your ideas as to how you would address those challenges.***

### **4-H PEI - Alumni Scholarship (\$1,000)**

- One Scholarship of \$1,000 awarded to a Grade 12 student **OR** a student currently enrolled in/returning to Post-Secondary Education in the fall of **2019**.

**\*\*Applicants are asked to prepare a 1000 word PROPOSAL introducing a NEW 4-H Project**

*Include learning outcomes, achievement day requirements, an exhibition item (if applicable), and project meeting ideas. Identify where leaders, or other resource people, such as judges and guest speakers/ facilitators, might be found for this project. Explain why you believe this project will add value to 4-H PEI and to your community.*

### **\*\*NEW\*\* - Cavendish Agri-Services - 4-H PEI Scholarship (5 @ \$1,000)**

- TWO Scholarships of \$1,000 awarded to a Grade 12 student
- THREE Scholarships of \$1,000 each, awarded to students currently enrolled in/returning to Post-Secondary Education in the fall of **2019**.

**\*\*Applicants are asked to prepare a 1000 - 1500 word ESSAY on one of the following topics:**

1. *What is the greatest concern for food production over the next 50 years?*
2. *How can we educate urban populations about where our food comes from and the industry standards involved?*
3. *Food waste: What is the global impact and who is responsible for making a change?*

**Travel Award interviews will take place on Monday, December 17, 2018**

(Location: Royalty Centre, 40 Enman Crescent, Charlottetown)

Applicants must:

- ✓ be completing Grade 12 from a recognized Island school of learning in the year the scholarship is awarded **OR** currently be enrolled in/returning to a recognized post-secondary school of learning.
- ✓ have completed at least two years in the 4-H PEI Program, and is currently an active member for the **2018-2019** 4-H year.
- ✓ be continuing with formal education at a recognized post-secondary school of learning beginning in September 2019.

**PLEASE NOTE:** *Applicants entering a post-secondary school of learning upon successful completion of Grade 11 are also eligible to apply for 4-H Scholarships.*

### **INFORMATION**

- ✓ Although 4-H members can apply for more than one scholarship opportunity, applicants can only be awarded with **ONE** provincially administered 4-H Scholarship per year.
- ✓ 4-H scholarships will be paid out in two installments:  
*1<sup>st</sup> installment of \$500.00 in September / 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of \$500.00 in December*
- ✓ In the event that the recipient should choose to discontinue his/her studies at any time during the year, he/she is then required to notify the 4-H PEI Office and refund the remaining portion of the scholarship that has not been utilized.
- ✓ In the event that more than 10 applications are received for any one scholarship, the essay and/or proposal will be judged first to determine those applicants who will receive an interview.

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Only **one** application form is required – even if applying for both scholarships.
- Applicant must indicate the 4-H Scholarship(s) for which he/she would like to be considered. Applications will not be returned - please keep a copy for your own reference.
- ONE Letter of Recommendation** must be submitted on the applicant's behalf to the 4-H PEI Office on or before **Saturday, December 1, 2018.**

### Selection Criteria will be based on:

#### **Member Application:**

- Judges will be looking for proper grammar & overall neatness
- Applicants are asked to provide detailed responses (do not assume that the judges will be familiar with their individual involvement in the 4-H program)
- Original, typed (digital) applications are preferred over handwritten and/or pictures of completed documents. Handwritten applications will be accepted, but members are asked to ensure the applications are legible & to use a pen with blue or black ink (*for photocopying purposes*)
- Each Scholarship requires the submission of an essay or proposal. Please refer to the individual Scholarship (s) for essay/proposal topics.

Requirements for your written work are as follows:

- Must be **double spaced** typed or very neatly and clearly printed
- Must be original and follow the requested topic.
- Sources must be properly sited within the text and in bibliography.
- Pages must be numbered
- Please do not: Staple pages **OR** include your name (*within the document or in the heading*)

#### **Written Quiz:**

- Applicants will be quizzed on Club, District, Provincial and National 4-H Knowledge and Political Knowledge

#### **In-Person Interview:**

- Applicants to participate in an interview with a panel of judges, answering questions related to Past & Present 4-H Experience(s).
