1. Prosecco Il Fresco NV Villa Sandi Veneto, Italy	5.00	23.50	
Aromas of ripe golden apples, acacia, and honeysuckle are exhibited on the nose. On the palate, the wine is dry, fresh and fruit-driven with citrus and stone-fruit flavours.			
2. Rosato Il Fresco NV Villa Sandi Veneto, Italy	5.00	23.50	
Aromas of fresh berries and a hint of spice lead to a palate of crisp acidity and a creamy mouthfeel. This delightful sparkler is dry, fresh and zesty.			
3. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV Reims, France	65.00		
Beautiful colour with straw-yellow highlights. Abundant fine bubbles. Intense pleasant on the nose. Fruity at first, then hawthorn-flower and slightly musky. Pleasant harmony on the palate, good freshness and liveliness. Lingering fruitiness: apple and pear.			
4. Dom Perignon 2006 Epernay, France	190.00		
This vintage was a great success for Dom Perignon. A moderate period of weather was complemented by a few weeks of dry heat just before harvest. This resulted in a year of good yield and grape size. This is an elegant yet dense champagne with a delightful spicy note on the mid-palate.			
5. Champagne Gardet Brut Tradition NV Chigny-les-Roses, France	40.00		
Lively berry fruits are fused with nutty, honeyed, caramel Champagne tastes. Its generous Champagne flavours are captured in fine bubbles delivering a zesty, dry finish.			
6. Chapel Down Brut NV Tenterden Vineyards, England	37.50		
Elegant aromas of red apple, lemongrass and freshly baked bread together with hints of strawberry, citrus and quince on the palate. Crisp and fresh with lively acidity and fine persistent bubbles.			
7. Cuve Charles Gardet 2004	62.00		
The elegant lightly creamed mousse coats the mouth with soft lemon, brioche and fine nutty characters evolving through to a captivating finish of gala apple and freshly baked bread. A very fine bead sustains the long complex finish, unfurling further complexity with every sip.			
8. Charles Gardet brut Premier Cru Rose 2006	67.00		
A stunning Rose de Saignee with flavours of red currants, blackcurrants, blackberries and even stewed fruits combine with a graceful, silky textured body. The near-perfect balance holds firm all the way to the long, sensual finish.

In the glass we get classic rose aromas, light strawberry, bright raspberry and the palate is lean, crisp and fresh. The finish is light and fresh.				
10. Rose d'Anjou Bonhomme (2)	4.90	6.90	19.50	
Loire, France				
Almost medium dry; salmon pink in colour. This wine has delightful fruit flavours and aromas.				
11. Zinfandel Angels Flight (4)	5.60	7.70	22.50	
California, USA				
A juicy refreshing rosé packed full of crushed strawberry and raspberry fruit. The finish is well balanced with a hint of sweetness.				



RED WINE

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Spicy, Peppery & Warming
12. Valpolicella Ripasso 2014, Villalta (C)
Veneto, Italy
Intense ruby-red colour, with a complex bouquet, reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants.
13. Carmenere Turi (B)
Central Valley, Chile
Ruby, bright flavours of ripe cherry fruit. Full-bodied, aromatic and elegant. Robust enough to pair with complex dishes or enjoy on its own, yet never heavy on the palate.



14. Côtes du Rhône Vieilles Vignes (C)	22.00
Les Coteaux du Rhône, France	

Lovely soft fruit with spice, plums, herbs and a touch of leather behind. Quite forward in the mouth with soft, ripe tannins, great length and a luscious finish. This is the second wine of Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe.

15. Shiraz Special Reserve (C)	5.90	8.10	24.00
Monsoon Valley, Thailand			

Exceptionally rich grapes due to the Mediterranean-like climate and sea breeze, that has allowed them to develop deep, rich flavours. This Shiraz is well-balanced and structured, with wonderful aromas of ripe plum, sour cherries and subtle notes of spice and coffee.

Elegant and Ripe

16. Malbec - Gouguenheim (C)	21.00
Mendoza, Argentina	

Big cherry and plum flavours with classic Malbec bite to finish. Argentina's keynote grape at its finest.

17. Rioja Crianza Vega (C)	6.00	8.30	24.50
Rioja, Spain			

Intense cherry red colour. Ripe aromas of blackcurrants and cherries with well integrated toasted notes of cinnamon, caramelised toffee and butter. A soft and easy drinking wine with notes of blackberries and spicy vanilla with a harmonious and round finish.

18. Merlot - Le Charme (B)	4.20	6.00	17.00
IGP, France			

The colour is a deep ruby red. The nose is very charming with its red berries fruit and spicy notes.

19. Old Vine Zinfandel, Smoking Loon (D)	28.00
California, USA	

Juicy aromas of plum, raspberry and mocha. On the palate, cherry, pomegranate and clove dominate. In the background, dill and vanilla hints.

Soft and Velvety

20. Al Muvredre 2014, Telmo Rodriguez (B)	23.50
Alicante, Spain	

Deep ruby. Intense aroma full of black cherry & black plum. A touch of smoky oak, clove & liquorice.

21. Chianti Duca di Sassetta (B)	6.00	8.30	24.50
Tuscany, Italy			

Soft and flavoursome Chianti with good depth, red fruit and easy tannins on the finish. This wine aims to produce modern style wines that are very drinkable.

22. Sancerre Rouge 2014, Domaine Sylvain Bailly (A)	36.00
Buë, France	

Aromas of red fruits on the nose of raspberry and blackcurrant. On the palate it is fruity with black cherry.

23. Pinot Noir - Lauteral (A)	4.90	6.90	19.50
Romania			

Fragrant and fruity Pinot Noir with plenty of ripe red fruits, strawberries and raspberries, fresh and crunchy with hints of spice.

WHITE WINE

24. Basa Telmo Rodriguez (1)	23.50
Rueda, Spain	

This crisp, clean Spanish white wine is more akin to Riesling or Sauvignon Blanc. With lightly floral, spicy aromatics, the palate also shows pear and citrus characters that finish clean and pure.

25. Sancerre 'Le Perrier' Domaine Thomas (1)	32.00
Loire, France	

Clean, fresh cut grass on the bouquet, overt and expansive palate with ripe gooseberries giving an added weight.

26. Sauvignon Blanc - Kuki (2)	5.90	8.10	24.00
Marlborough, NZ			

Superb mineral texture with a wonderful layered stream of flavours developing on your palate. Fruity grapefruit with that distinctive 'cut grass' note on the nose leading to a zesty finish.

27. Chardonnay - Le Charme (2)	4.20	6.00	17.00
IGP, France			

Soft, easy drinking dry white with rounded tropical fruit and no oak.

Elegant, Light and Fresh

28. Picpoul du Pinet, Domaine de la Serre (1)	24.50
Languedoc, France	

Crisp and dry on the palate with additional notes of peach and melon, there is a backbone of intense minerality and a zippy, clean acidity that work together to deliver a long refreshing finish.

29. Surrey Gold, Denbies Estate (3)	26.50
Surrey, England	

A pronounced floral, honeysuckle and peach infused nose leads to a well-structured palate.

30. Pinot Grigio, Villa Sandi (1)	5.60	7.80	23.00
Veneto, Italy			

Light stone fruits, floral notes and a hint of lemon drops with a mineral core running through the wine leading to a crisp finish.

31. Vouvray La Forcine (3)	5.80	8.00	23.50
August Bonhomme, Loire, France			

Friendly green apple and fig notes bounce along, with an off-dry hint, but this stays zippy, with green almond and floral accents lining the finish.

Aromatic, Vibrant and Juicy

32. Gewurztraminer Reserva (3)	19.50
Alto Los Romeros, Chile	

A fresh and expressive Gewürztraminer with a lychee flavour, this is perfect for spicier dishes.

33. Colombard Premium Monsoon (2)	25.90	8.10	24.00
Hua Hin Hills, Thailand			

A light straw yellow with a lifted nose of well ripened gooseberry, green apple, passion fruit and a touch of Sauvignon Blanc's character. Sweet fruit and punchy flavours.

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Classic Whites

Our Classic white wine selection delivers an impressive choice from the Chablis and Burgundy regions home to Chardonnay!

A superb 1er Cru Chablis with concentrated fruits and steely minerality; for richer more complex styles we have a Meursault displaying nutty, toasty oak with opulent richness and purity of fruit. Then slightly further south we find the Maconnais regions most famous Cru – Pouilly Fuisse a complex, creamy and textual example of Chardonnay at its best!

36. Chablis 1er Cru Montee de Tonnerre (1)	48.00
Domaine Philippe Testut, France	

An impressively rich bouquet with pronounced apple and citrus aromas.

37. Pouilly Fuisse Tete de Cru 2013 (2)	55.00
Burgundy, France	

There are floral notes on the nose with a lightness of touch, plenty of mineral character with super ripe fruit.

38. Meursault 2011, Domaine Bernard Michelot (2)	65.00
Burgundy, France	

This wine has nutty, toasty oak adding the depth and richness to the citrus, apple and melon fruit.

Traditional Reds

Our traditional reds take us on a journey through the famous wine regions of France. In Burgundy we have Gevrey-Chambertin with soft, elegant structure that retains the rich fruit of the best Pinot Noir from the Côte de Nuits. Vieux Télégraphe is one of the most renowned estates of the Southern Rhône; its second wine 'Telegramme' is beautiful, exuberant and stylish, medium to full-bodied richness with a fleshy, ripe, supple profile. Finally to Bordeaux where our Grand Cru St Emilion a blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc is an elegant, balanced, attractive wine with crisp fruit, a pure and complete palate and good length.

39. Chateauneuf du Pape Telegramme (D)	48.00
