So we see that the prophet Isaiah was Cleary talking about the King of Babylon.

A lot of people after quoting Isaiah 14:11 will Immediately Jump into Ezekiel 28:13-15 and state this is Satan (Hasatan).

The Problem here is Ezekiel 28 is not referring to Lucifer neither is it referring to the devil, but it to is a proverb.

LET'S SEE

The word of Yahuah came again unto me, saying,

<sup>2</sup> Son of man, <u>say unto the prince of Tyrus</u>, Thus saith Yahuah Elohim; Because thine heart is lifted up, and thou hast said, I am a God, I sit in the seat of Elohim, in the midst of the seas; <u>yet thou art a man</u>, and not Elohim, though thou set thine heart as the heart of Elohim:

EZEKIEL 28:1-2

So clearly we don't Have to go any further to see this is talking about a man and not Satan.

# HOWEVER LET GET TO THE MEAT OF THE DOCTRINE WITH THIS UNDERSTANDING.

- <sup>12</sup> Son of man, <u>take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus</u>, and say unto him, Thus saith Yahuah Elohim; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.

If one was to read just this they would easily say it makes since however. We see in the scripture it is clearly speaking about the Prince of Tyre and the King of Tyre. The prince of Tyre is compared not with Satan but with Adam in (metaphor). He was originally blameless—a wise king who gained great wealth (28:3-5)—but he became proud and violent; therefore, Elohim cast him from the garden, which is also the "mountain of Elohim". The fall of Adam is used as a metaphor for the corruption of the king who in the end thought he could become like Elohim. The lamentation concludes with the humiliation of the king, and the assurance that he "shall be no more forever".

- <sup>7</sup> And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,

DRAGON JOB 41:1-4 leviathan, sea monster, dragon

large aquatic animal

perhaps the extinct dinosaur, plesiosaurus, exact meaning unknown

Some think this to be a crocodile but from the description in Job 41:1-34 this is patently absurd. It appears to be a large fire breathing animal of some sort. Just as the bomardier beetle has an explosion producing mechanism, so the great sea dragon may have an explosive producing mechanism to enable it to be a real fire breathing dragon.
