salach is used it expresses the divine pardon extended to the sinner

Numbers 14:19-20

¹⁹ **Pardon**, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

²⁰ And Yahuah said, I have **pardoned** according to thy word:

2 Chronicles 6:30-34

Then hear thou from heaven thy dwelling place, and **forgive**, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart thou knowest; (for thou only knowest the hearts of the children of men:)

³¹ That they may fear thee, to walk in thy ways, so long as they live in the land which thou gavest unto our fathers.

³² Moreover concerning the stranger, which is not of thy people Israel, but is come from a far country for thy great name's sake, and thy mighty hand, and thy stretched out arm; if they come and pray in this house;

³³ Then hear thou from the heavens, even from thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for; that all people of the earth may know thy name, and fear thee, as doth thy people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by thy name.

³⁴ If thy people go out to war against their enemies by the way that thou shalt send them, and they pray unto thee toward this city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name;

2 Chronicles 6:35-39

³⁵ Then hear thou from the heavens their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause.

³⁶ If they sin against thee, (for there is no man which sinneth not,) and thou be angry with them, and deliver them over before their enemies, and they carry them away captives unto a land far off or near;

³⁷ Yet if they bethink themselves in the land whither they are carried captive, and turn and pray unto thee in the land of their captivity, saying, We have sinned, we have done amiss, and have dealt wickedly;

³⁸ If they return to thee with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their captivity, whither they have carried them captives, and pray toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, and toward the city which thou hast chosen, and toward the house which I have built for thy name:

³⁹ Then hear thou from the heavens, even from thy dwelling place, their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and **forgive** thy people which have sinned against thee.

2 Chronicles 7:14

¹⁴ If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will **forgive** their sin, and will heal their land.

2 Chronicle 6:30

Then hear thou from heaven thy dwelling place, and **forgive**, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, **whose heart thou knowest; (for thou only knowest the hearts of the children of men:)**

Jeremiah 17:9

⁹ The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: **who can know it?**

¹⁰ I Yahuah search the heart, I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings.

Leviticus 19:22

And the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering before Yahauah for his sin which he hath done: and the sin which he hath done shall be forgiven him.

Genesis 22:13

“And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind *him* a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.”

Leviticus 5:15-16, 18

If a soul commit a trespass, and **sin through ignorance**, in the holy things of Yahuah; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a trespass offering.

¹⁶ And he shall make amends for the harm that he hath done in the holy thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering, and it shall be **forgiven** him.

¹⁸ And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest: and the **priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance** wherein he erred and wist it not, and it shall be **forgiven** him.

Deuteronomy 29:16-20

¹⁶ (For ye know how we have dwelt in the land of Egypt; and how we came through the nations which ye passed by;

¹⁷ And ye have seen their abominations, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which were among them:)

¹⁸ Lest there should be among you man, or woman, or family, or tribe, whose heart turneth away this day from Yahuah our Alahym, to go and serve the powers of these nations; lest there should be among you a root that beareth gall and wormwood;

¹⁹ And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst:

²⁰ Yahuah will not spare him, but then the anger of Yahuah and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and Yahuah shall blot out his name from under heaven.

1 Kings 8:30,34,36,39,50

³⁰ And hearken thou to the supplication of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, when they shall pray toward this place: and hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place: and when thou hearest, **forgive**.

³⁴ Then hear thou in heaven, and **forgive** the sin of thy people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which thou gavest unto their fathers.

³⁶ Then hear thou in heaven, and **forgive** the sin of thy servants, and of thy people Israel, that thou teach them the good way wherein they should walk, and give rain upon thy land, which thou hast given to thy people for an inheritance.

³⁹ Then hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and **forgive**, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, whose heart thou knowest; (for thou, even thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men;)

⁵⁰ And **forgive** thy people that have sinned against thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them:

Exodus 34:9

And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O YAHUAH, let my YAHUAH, I pray thee, go among us; for it is a stiffnecked people; and **pardon** our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance.

⁵⁹ And let these my words, wherewith I have made supplication before Yahuah, be nigh unto Yahuah our Alahym day and night, that he maintain the cause of his servant, and the cause of his people Israel at all times, as the matter shall require:

⁶⁰ That all the people of the earth may know that Yahuah is Alahym, and that there is none else.
