BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE; BE NOT AFRAID

Joshua 1:9

Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for Yahuah thy Aluhim is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

Be strong and of a good courage

- 1. Be strong = H2338
- 2. And of A Good Courage = H553
- 3. Be not Afraid = H6206

H2388 - chazaq a primitive root; to fasten upon; hence, to seize, be strong (figuratively, courageous, causatively strengthen, cure, help, repair, fortify), obstinate; to bind, restrain, conquer:—aid, amend, × calker, catch, cleave, confirm, be constant, constrain, continue, be of good (take) courage(-ous, -ly), encourage (self), be established, fasten, force, fortify, make hard, harden, help, (lay) hold (fast), lean, maintain, play the man, mend, become (wax) mighty, prevail, be recovered, repair, retain, seize, be (wax) sore, strengthen (self), be stout, be (make, shew, wax) strong(-er), be sure, take (hold), be urgent, behave self valiantly, withstand.

H553 - 'amats a primitive root; to be alert, physically (on foot) or mentally (in courage):—confirm, be courageous (of good courage, stedfastly minded, strong, stronger), establish, fortify, harden, increase, prevail, strengthen (self), make strong (obstinate, speed).

H6206 - 'arats a primitive root; to awe or (intransitive) to dread; hence, to harass:—be affrighted (afraid, dread, feared, terrified), break, dread, fear, oppress, prevail, shake terribly.

Deuteronomy 31:6-7

⁶ **châzaq âmats, ârats**, nor be afraid of them: for the YAHUAH thy Aluhim, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

⁷ And Moses called unto Joshua, and said unto him in the sight of all Yisrael, **châzaq âmats**: for thou must go with this people unto the land which Yahuah hath sworn unto their fathers to give them; and thou shalt cause them to inherit it.

Deuteronomy 31:23

And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge, and said, châzaq âmats: for thou shalt bring the children of Yisrael into the land which I sware unto them: and I will be with thee.

Fear has crept into the Masses

2 Timothy 1:7

Numbers 14:24

But my servant Caleb, because he had another Ruach with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it.

Keep Yourself from a fainthearted H7390

- Deuteronomy 20:8
- And the officers shall speak further unto the people, and they shall say, What man is there that is fearful and fainthearted_{H7390}? **let him go and return unto his house, lest his brethren's heart faint**_{H4549} as well as his heart.
- rak, H7390; tender (literally or figuratively); by implication, weak:—faint(-hearted), soft, tender ((-hearted), one), weak.
- maw-sas'H4549; a primitive root; to liquefy; figuratively, to waste (with disease), to faint (with fatigue, fear or grief):—discourage, faint, be loosed, melt (away), refuse, x utterly.

1 Corinthians 2:12

• Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Ruach which is of Aluhim; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of Aluhim.

- Numbers 13:30-33
- 30 And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it.
- 31 But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they *αre* stronger than we.
- 32 And they brought up an evil report of the land which they had searched unto the children of Israel, saying, The land, through which we have gone to search it, is a land that eateth up the inhabitants thereof; and all the people that we saw in it are men of a great stature.

- ⁶ And Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, which were of them that searched the land, rent their clothes:
- ⁷ And they spake unto all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land.
- ⁸ If Yahuah delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land which floweth with milk and honey.
- ⁹ Only rebel not ye against Yahuah, neither fear ye the people of the land; for they are bread for us: their defence is departed from them, and Yahuah is with us: fear them not.
- ¹⁰ But all the congregation bade stone them with stones. And the glory of Yahuah appeared in the tabernacle of the congregation before all the children of Israel.
- ¹¹ And <u>Yahuah said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me</u>? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- ¹² I will smite them with the pestilence_{H1698}, and disinherit them, and will make of thee a greater nation and mightier than they.
