CHETWYND GETS FUNDING FOR UPGRAD EWATER TREATMENT



Residents of Chetwynd will benefit from improved wastewater infrastructure thanks to joint funding from the governments of Canada and British Columbia through the Small Communities Fund.

The planned upgrades to the Wastewater Lagoon Treatment Facility include the construction of a concrete aeration tank; the installation of blowers, underground piping, and an emergency generator; as well as the associated electrical works and monitoring equipment. These improvements will help reduce the quantity and improve the quality of treated water flowing into the Pine River, and ensure that the system complies with current

SAULTEAU FIRST NATION MEMBERS VOTE IN FAVOUR OF SITE C AGREEMENT

The Saulteau First Nations have voted in favour of an Impact Benefits Agreement with BC Hydro over the Site C dam.

According to an article in the Alaska Highway News, Chief Nathan Parenteau confirmed that the Saulteau First Nation will not join other Treaty 8 Nations in legal challenges after the Treaty 8 member voted in favour of the agreement.

The nation of over 1,000 members voted through an online referendum held last week. Sixty-two per cent voted in favour of the agreement, 37.8 per cent voted against it and 0.7 per cent abstained.

Details of Saulteau's benefits agreement are not being released, but Parenteau has confirmed that it includes both lump sum and annual payments, and that they will also be given Crown land to compensate for territory lost to the dam's reservoir.

The move comes about a week after McLeod Indian Band backed out of a lawsuit against the dam.

A water strategy program will be funded by BC Hydro to deal with changes to the Moberly River, part of which will be converted into the dam's reservoir.

As part of the deal, the Crown corporation will also fund a moose management plan, create a cultural continuity fund and bring community investments to the reserve.



MAN ARRESTED IN FORT ST. JOHN ON TERRORISM CHARGES

On Friday, the RCMP Integrated National Security Enforcement Team arrested 33 year-old Othman Ayed Hamdan of Fort St. John, and charged him for committing terrorism offences contrary to Section 83.2 of the Criminal Code.

Hamdan is charged with two counts each of: counseling to commit murder for the benefit of a terrorist group; counseling to assault causing bodily harm for the benefit of a terrorist group; counseling to commit aggravated assault for the benefit of a terrorist group.

S.Sgt. Julie Gagnon with the RCMP in Ottawa said that three of the offences are alleged to have occurred on March 21, 2015 and the other three between Sept. 22, 2014 and July 9, 2015. Fort St. John Mayor Lori Ackerman told the Vancouver Sun the news of a terrorism arrest in Fort St. John came as "a surprise", but she said she is pleased at how INSET "worked closely with our detachment to deal with this issue and the importance that they placed on it because of the security of all Canadians."

Members of the local muslim community say they didn't know the suspect arrested on Friday and charged with several terrorism charges. Azhar Phoolwala, who is the head of the local Muslim association says no one in his community knew the suspect. Phoolwala says Hamdan was never seen at Fort St John's mosque or any prayer meetings. According to an article in the Vancouver Sun, Hamdan is scheduled to appear in court today, however the RCMP have not offered any confirmation. 
