Suspicious Activity at Dawson Creek Business Leads to Seizure of Guns and Drugs

On Friday, August 7th, 2020, Dawson Creek RCMP received a report of suspicious activity from a local business. The behavior of the customers prompted the bushiness to call police, providing a description of the individuals as well as the vehicle they were driving.

A short time later, the vehicle was seen leaving a known drug house in the community and police attempted to stop the vehicle. The vehicle fled from police however, later came to a stop after making multiple attempts to evade the police. The driver and passenger were arrested without further incident.

During the investigation, police recovered a stolen 9mm Chiappa rifle with a loaded magazine. A box of 9mm ammo along with a metal airsoft handgun with a live .22 cal round in the breech.

Further evidence led police to executing two search warrants at two separate residences in Dawson Creek on Monday, August 10 2020 where police seized suspected cocaine, meth and fentanyl, over \$4000 in cash and multiple firearms. The two suspects were held in police custody for a court appearance on Tuesday August 11 2020. The investigation is ongoing.



- INGREDIENTS (Makes 16 servings)

 16 medium-large white button mushrooms

 Vegetable oil
- 300 grams ground sausage meat (Italian or other)
- onion
- 2 celery sticks

- 1 garlic clove Salt and pepper
- 300 grams thinly sliced cheese (choose a flavourful variety that melts ell like Gruyere, cheddar or Emmenthal)

- Carefully cut off the mushroom stems. Heat a small amount of vegetable oil in a skillet and brown the sausage meat. Finely chop the onion, celery, mushroom stems and garlic and cook with the sausage for 5 to 7 minutes, or until the meat is cooked through and the onions are translucent. Season with
- 2. Once the mixture has cooled, stuff the mushrooms and cover each one with a slice
- 3. Preheat the barbecue to medium heat. Place the mushrooms on the grill and close the lid (or cover with a large metal bowl). Cook for 6 to 8 minutes until the mushrooms are nice and tender and the cheese has melted. Serve as an appetizer or a side dish.





Mouth-watering oven-baked BBO ribs



No matter which method you swear by when it comes to cooking ribs — boiling, grilling, smoking — give your oven its chance to shine. You won't be disappointed by these fall-off-the-bone ribs, which cook for 4 to 6 hours to achieve flavour perfection. You can prepare them ahead of time and reheat them on the grill for a few minutes before serving.

Keep in mind that ribs are traditionally served dripping in BBQ sauce, so don't be surprised if a guest or two ask you for some. It's not a crime, but as the chef, it's up to you to politely insist that everybody taste at least one of your perfectly seasoned ribs before cracking out the bottle.

INGREDIENTS (Makes 8 servings)

- 1/3 cup salt
- 1/3 cup paprika
- 1/3 cup chilli powder
- · 2 tbsp. garlic powder
- · 2 tbsp. onion powder
- · 2 tbsp. dried thyme
- · 2 tbsp. dried oregano
- · 2 tbsp. dried basil
- 2 tbsp. ground pepper
- 1 tsp. cumin
- 1 tsp. Cayenne pepper
- 3 to 4 kg back ribs (about 1/2 rack per serving)

Cooked ribs

can be stored in the

refrigerator for up

to 3 days.

PREPARATION

- 1. The day before, mix all of the dry ingredients together with an electric mixer. Spread the dry rub on the fleshy side of the meat, pressing down firmly to ensure everything sticks. Place the ribs in a resealable plastic bag and refrigerate overnight.
- 2. Preheat oven to 275 °F (135 °C). In a large roasting pan, spread the pieces of meat out in a single row. Carefully cover with aluminum foil, making sure the ribs don't stick to the foil too much.
- 3. Bake for 4 to 6 hours, or until the meat easily falls off the bone. If you plan on serving the ribs later, cut the rack into individual pieces so that they're easier to warm up on the grill.

- 1. Choreograph a dance, This is a great way for kids to exercise their mind and body. Opt for a song that encourages dynamic movement and record their performance to share with loved ones. In addition to the workout, this assignment requires your children to use their memory and creativity.
- 2.Plant a garden, From transplanting sprouts to monitoring the soil's moisture level, gardening can teach your children a lot about nature in a hands-on way. This ongoing science project gives them the opportunity to learn about different plant species and potentially grow their own food.



COVID-19: how to stop the spread of conspiracy theories

Misinformation about the coronavirus is being spread online at an alarming rate. While conspiracy theories about COVID-19 might sound absurd to some people, there are a number of unfounded claims that continue to circulate freely. Here's what you should do.

Avoid sharing false information Here are a few of the theories being disseminated online, primarily on social media platforms.

- •COVID-19 is a biological weapon designed in a Chinese laboratory
- •The virus is a cover-up meant to conceal the harmful effects of 5G wireless technology
- •A vaccine or treatment for COVID-19 exists but authorities are hiding it from the public
- •The eventual vaccine will contain a microchip that allows Bill Gates to control people

It's best to avoid reposting these stories or engaging with them in any way.

Learn to be skeptical

Conspiracy theories that go viral can seriously impact the real world. Before you share a story about the pandemic on social media, remember that false claims tend to:

- •Discredit accurate information from political leaders, the scientific community and credible news outlets
- Generate negative emotions such as fear, anger and anxiety
- •Give a voice to individuals or groups with questionable motives
- •Incite dangerous (and potentially illegal) actions that can threaten public health and safety

Remember, "fake news" is based on hearsay and assumptions, not verified facts.

Now more than ever, it's essential that you take the time to distinguish fact from fiction. Make sure the information and stories you share are from reputable sources.
