STAN FRASER JUST OVER HALF WAY DONE 'WALK AND TALK THE PEACE'

63 year old Chetwynd resident Stan Fraser is on day 9 of "Walk and Talk the Peace." He started the walk in Fort Nelson on August 20th, and will be done September 2nd in Chetwynd. The goal of his journey is to bring awareness to mental health issues, to get people talking about it, and to get people involved.

This is his third year doing the walk. The first year he went from Chetwynd, to Dawson Creek, to Fort St John, and then back again. This year, he started in Fort Nelson and will end in Chetwynd, with stops all along the way to talk to communities and get the message out.

Stan mentioned that whoever wants to stop and talk or walk along the way is welcome. Covid-19 has required that he do things a little differently than he would have normally. He noted that in that way, it reflects what he's trying to do with this walk, namely to get people to see and do things differently than they would have. To accept new normals, and to approach things from a different angle.

"It's to reduce the judgement of how we've become. To bring us closer together, to bring more understanding, to bring us closer as a family, as a community, and to join together with other communities," he commented while on the phone. At the time, he was heading into an area with no cell phone coverage.

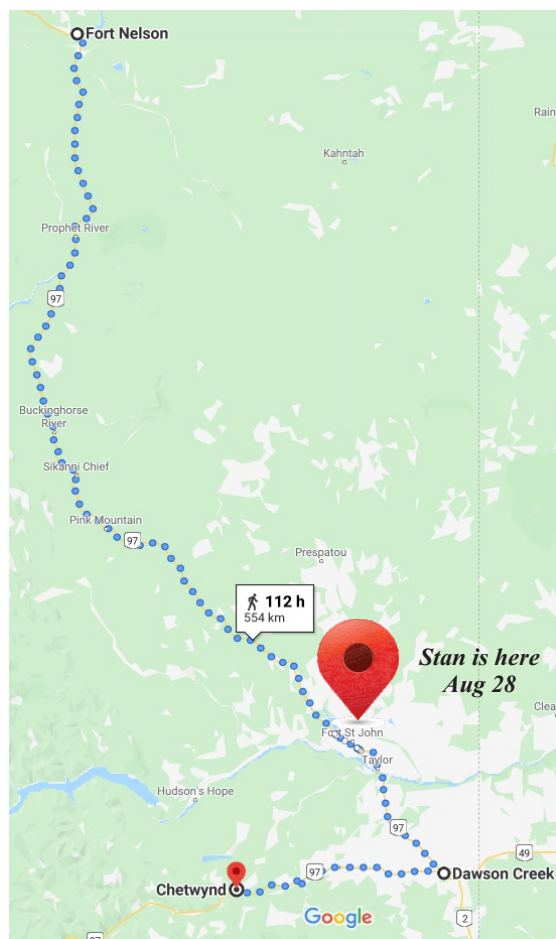
He's excited about how many people have recently engaged on social media. "That's what it's all about, getting people talking."

Stan said there are already people in Fort Nelson organizing other walks and talking about these important issues. "Fort Nelson was a huge success, people are getting involved," he said. "It's been a very humbling experience."

Stan says he has an amazing committee in Chetwynd that does most of the work and the behind-the-scenes planning, he's just the guy that does the walking.

Stan needs to complete 40-50kms a day to reach Chetwynd by September 2nd, which works out to 8-10 hours a day. "It's a challenge, but it's a challenge I look forward to."

He said he'd like to see hundreds of people join him in walking when he arrives in Chetwynd. He joked that if they don't walk with him, then they'd better at least cheer really loudly!

PREMIER'S STATEMENT ON WTO PANEL REPORT ON SOFTWOOD LUMBER

Premier John Horgan has issued the following statement in response to the World Trade Organization (WTO) panel report on U.S. countervailing duties on Canadian softwood lumber:

"We are pleased that the WTO panel ruling supports Canada's challenge of U.S. countervailing duties on softwood lumber. We have continuously worked alongside the federal government on this long, difficult softwood lumber dispute. The forest sector is vital to our province's economy and to the hard-working people whose livelihoods depend on it.

"We have always maintained that B.C.'s forest policies are trade compliant. This ruling by the WTO, yet again, confirms that.

"While this decision is a victory for B.C.'s lumber producers, immediate relief is unlikely. Our work continues until we bring an end to the unfair U.S. duties on Canadian softwood lumber exports."

Halfway River closed to boaters September–April

A 2-km section of the Halfway River will be closed to boaters from September 1, 2020 to April 30, 2021, as BC Hydro clears vegetation to prepare for the Site C reservoir.

During this time, six temporary crossings will be built across the river to transport logs and equipment during the winter clearing season.

The river will be re-opened and the crossings removed by May 2021, in time for the next boating season.

Boaters will continue to be able to access the Peace River from the Halfway River boat launch.

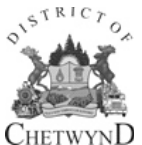

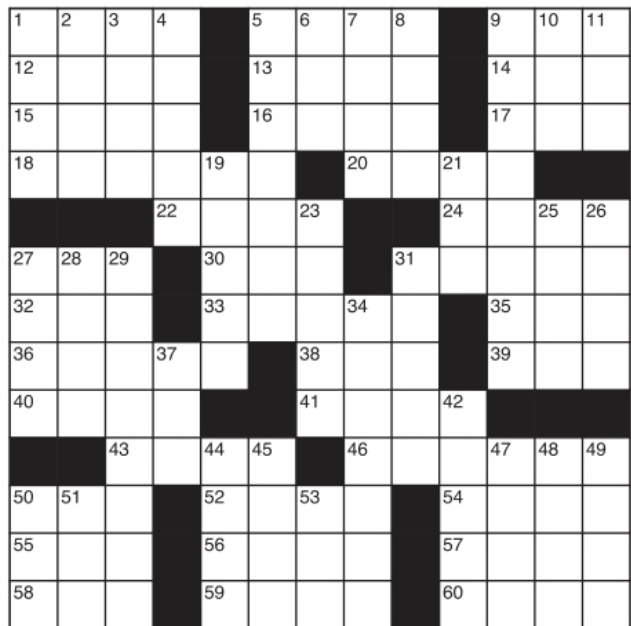
