LAWN MOWER SAFETY

After an incident that happened to me while mowing my lawn last week, I feel the need to remind everyone of the safety precautions that should be taken while using your push or ride on mower. Even after walking my yard, I hit an unseen rock and it shot out like a bullet and hit my truck, leaving a decent dent in my fender. My first thought was, "what if my kids were in the vard?"

Tragedy can occur when a child falls off a ride-on mower while riding with an adult, when a ride-on mower is placed into reverse and the operator is unaware that a child is behind, when a child is too young to handle a lawn mower, or when debris is thrown by a mower and strikes a child.

32% of injuries by a lawn mower are severe lacerations, and 16% are amputations. Many of these injuries occure in children 15 and younger, using push mowers. The most common mishap is slipping or tripping and losing feet under the mower.

Before mowing, walk around the yard and look out for hazards including tree stumps and holes, pick up debris including stones, sticks, toys etc. and keep children out of the yard when it is being mowed.

These steps and the use of common sense such as not drinking alcoholic beverages, using your cell phone while mowing, and taking small children for rides while the blade is spinning can also prevent a lot of unwanted grief.

MAYOR'S REPORT

If it had been just me, I would have remained silent.

As the voters of Chetwynd spoke in the last election, I have the privilege of working with a Council that is the envy of communities less blessed. We don't always agree and even the Mayor gets voted down from time to time. That's exactly how good government should happen. If every member of Council agreed with the Mayor, what would be the point of electing a Council? Just let the Mayor make all the decisions. Cheaper. Faster. More efficient. And you would know whom to blame.

I will review with you one of the rules under which Mayor and Council operate. It is more than a rule. It is the law. Every Council, from time to time, has to deal with issues of labour, land, and contract negotiations. These, by nature, are sensitive, and open discussion would jeopardize successful conclusions and, potentially, lives and finances. These discussions must be held *in camera*, meaning behind closed doors and with participating persons obligated to remain silent on all aspects of the discussion until Council, as a body, authorizes disclosure.

Because the District of Chetwynd Council is engaged in a number of discussions that fall under this law, we have been holding in camera sessions at least twice monthly.

Any person who has served even one term on Council or as a Mayor should know and understand the necessity of keeping sensitive topics in camera until disclosure is appropriate.

If it had been just me, I would have remained silent. However, I feel that the best Council in British Columbia has been attacked and slandered publicly and I have an obligation to come to the defense of my team.

To compare Council, especially this Council, to Adolph Hitler shows a remarkable lack of understanding of Nazism, and the whole evil regime that subjected the world to years of mayhem, murder, and madness.

As any former or present elected official knows, Councils have to make decisions from time to time that are not popular with some of the electorate. The issue that precipitated the Hitler reference is one of these. In this case, Council's choice was between enforcing a bylaw or ignoring its violation. In two separate but related items at the June 5, 2017, Council meeting, Council voted to receive the May 26 letter from Skye Blue Solutions Inc. (which means that no action would be taken) and to ratify the May 23 in-camera decision to rescind the May 15

directive to Administration to "schedule a public information meeting to allow all interested parties to discuss zoning matters in relation to RU 2 zones" (rural residential).

In answer to a public question at the June 5 Council meeting, I stated that if the issue of public discussion of RU 2 zoning came up again it would have to be with a different Council.

To engage in further public discussion, at the request of one of the proponents, on a sensitive topic that, by this Council's decision, is not going to move forward, would send the wrong message and give hope and concern where no hope or concern is warranted. Hence, the decision to place the latest submission on the topic from Skye Blue Solutions Inc. under Information items where it would be visible but not open to discussion unless a Council member chose to pull it for discussion.

Council is elected to represent the entire community, to enforce existing bylaws, and to govern. This is what the team you elected is doing and it is doing it well.














KELSEY'S CHRONICLE



Canada Day is tomorrow, and what better way to celebrate our country's 150th birthday than to throw a big ol' party? Many of us have our festivities, food and decor all set up and others fly by the seat of their pants. Whichever way you roll, If you're still looking for some things to spice up your shindig, here's a few ideas.
