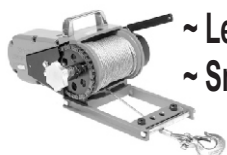

FIRST NATIONS GROUPS FILE CASE AGAINST BC HYDRO

Two First Nations groups in the Peace have officially banded together to take on BC Hydro.

The West Moberly and Prophet River First Nations are requesting declarations that the approvals the company issued for the Site C project are unconstitutional and should be void.

The groups are also seeking injunctions that would prohibit further approvals by the government regarding the dam's construction.

The controversial project is not the only one mentioned in the Supreme Court case filing however, as the groups claim all three dams built on the Peace River infringe upon their treaty rights.

These include the WAC Bennett Dam, and the Peace Canyon Dam as well.

They claim that these dams are turning the river into a series of reservoirs, and seriously harming the cultural and ecological character of the Peace.

The filing, which has been speculated about for over a month, also seeks to include an application for disclosure of unreleased documents.

NEW INITIATIVES COMING TO NORTH

Two new funding campaigns seek to invest 1.65 million dollars in to innovation in Northern BC.

The initiatives were announced at the True North Business Development Forum in Prince George yesterday.

The Northern Industries Innovation fund will be investing 750 thousand dollars annually in small businesses in the North that seek to develop technology.

For individual businesses, this means they can apply for funding of up to 50 thousand dollars for projects in the energy, agricultural, aquacultural, and forestry industries.

The second program, the Strategic Initiatives Fund, is committing 900 thousand dollars to grants that will allow municipalities and First Nations groups to take on long term sustainability projects.

The Northern Industries Innovation Fund will accept applicants until the money is exhausted, while the Strategic Initiatives Fund will accept them until March 15th.

In an update on a previous story, the second degree murder trial of Leon Wokeley has been adjourned until February 21st.

Wokeley's lawyer, Georges Rivard, informed the court that Crown Counsel has provided him with a batch of disclosure in the form of a hard drive with thousands of pages of documents. He requested that Judge Brian Daley adjourn the case until February so he can review the documents and determine the best course of action to defend Wokeley. Wokeley has been charged with second degree murder in the 2014 death of First Nations resident Pamela Napoleon.

safeTALK, about three hours in duration, is a training that prepares anyone over the age of 15 to identify persons with thoughts of suicide and connect them to suicide first aid resources.

This program alerts community members to signs that a person may

be considering suicide. It acknowledges that while most people at risk of suicide signal their distress and invite help, these intervention opportunities are often overlooked. Participants learn to recognize when someone may have thoughts of suicide and to respond in ways that link them with further suicide intervention help.

It is intended that safeTALK participants will be better prepared to:

- recognize that invitations to help are often overlooked;
- move beyond common tendencies to miss, dismiss and avoid suicide;
- notice and respond to situations in which thoughts of suicide may be present;
- apply basic TALK steps (Tell, Ask, Listen, and KeepSafe); and
- connect the person with thoughts of suicide to suicide first aid help and further community resources.
