



## Public Round Table Hosted by Mike Bernier Regarding Forest Industry

A public round-table regarding the forestry industry in North Eastern BC was held in Chetwynd Wednesday evening.

Around fifteen people attended the event, which was held at the Chetwynd Recreation Centre. The discussion was hosted by MLA Mike Bernier. MLA Dan Davies, and MLA John Rustad attended as special guests.

Recent curtailments and closures, and well as discussions around the Caribou has caused much concern in local communities associated with forestry industries. MLA Mike Bernier opened the discussion by stressing the fact that all regions of the Peace need to work together on this issue.

Critic for the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations, and Rural Development, MLA John Rustad then took to the floor and addressed the current status of the industry.

Forestry directly employs around 5% - 6% percent of jobs in the province. A major driving force in the recent reductions in production is the fact that there has been an erosion of competitiveness in price for product produced in the province.

Reduction of production is also causing major concerns with industry contractors, who depend on forestry for consistent work.

Discussion about the caribou, government reaction, the consultation process, and the moratorium also took place.

Chetwynd Mayor Allen Courtoreille asked the MLAs how their party, should they form the next provincial government, would approach the caribou issue and the

2-year moratorium. MLA Mike Bernier stressed that he couldn't give any exact promises, but his party has been taking note of the things that need to be improved upon when approaching this issue.

The Mayor also asked if there were any measures local governments could take to get their concerns heard.

MLA Dan Davies suggested that local municipalities should be talking to each other and working together concerning this issue. The MLAs suggested that communities need to lobby and do whatever they can to get their voices heard by both the provincial and federal levels of government. Local residents can also be heard by e-mailing their provincial and federal representatives.

A representative from Work BC stated that they have seen an uptick in people approaching their office for information about other employment opportunities and employment insurance.

Softwood lumber was also briefly discussed. MLA Rustad stated that it is unlikely there would be any resolution to that issue until after the next American election.

Consultations with other communities affected by these issues will take place over the next few weeks.
