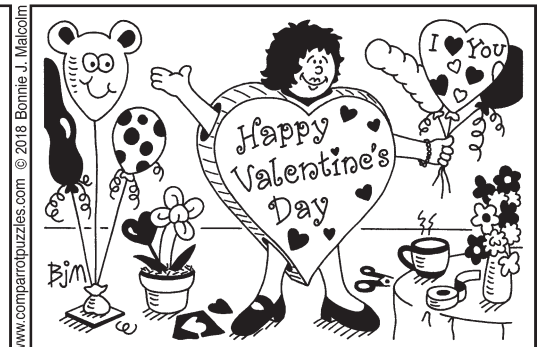

SNOW TIPS AND TRICKS TO KEEP YOURSELF SAFE

I was on my roof last weekend and removed enough snow that I didn't even need a ladder to get down. Now that's a lot of snow! With the snow never seeming to end this year, I thought I would re-visit some tips and tricks to help you remove your snow without hurting yourself.

The act of shovelling snow has been known to cause many injuries including pulled muscles, and sometimes even heart attacks. If while shovelling you begin to feel faint, have chest pain, or difficulty breathing, contact 911 immediately.

Before you begin you should always start with a full stretch. This is an important step that many people forget and regret later. Start with your neck and move down to shoulders, back (by leaning side to side, arms stretched over your head) and then to your hips and legs by bending and trying to touch your toes (only go as far as you can).

Take breaks consistently, sanction off areas and be sure to stop in between to help from over exerting yourself. Bend your knees when shovelling, you should feel it working your hamstrings and your butt, not your back!

Be sure to dress in layers. This will help you be able to remove a top layer if overheating without being left in a t-shirt or having to go in and change. Switch hands often and remove snow in layers if a lot has accumulated.

Think ahead and don't pile all the snow at the edge of the driveway. If possible, toss the snow further into the yard to create less of a barrier. Chances are, this won't be the last of the snow which will eventually crowd in and take up valuable parking space, if it hasn't already.

Try to acquire the help of some neighbourhood kids to help you, if you're able to. Many kids are willing to do the work for a lot less money than hiring a snow removal company, sometimes even just for hot chocolate and a cookie.

Lastly, if the snow is fluffy enough, try your leaf blower or shop vac on exhaust mode for a quick fix for vehicles, decks or small walkways (for vehicles- this works better when the vehicle is cold).

Keep safe and remember to takes breaks, lift with your knees and be stocked up on hot chocolate and cookies in the chance you can bribe some kids to help you out!
