New Scales for Chetwynd Landfill



The Peace River Regional District awarded a contract to Sperling Hansen Associates to replace the scales at the Chetwynd landfill at their recent meeting. Design and tender support will cost \$50,267.50, with \$5,315.50 per week for administration, quality control and construction during the project.

"It's just to keep our landfill more functional. And hopefully we get another year out of it, because we're scheduled to close this landfill in eight years," said Chetwynd Mayor Allen Courtoreille.

In 2018, regional district staff identified an opportunity to replace the scale, and this year a request for proposal was put out to find qualified professionals to complete the work. PRRD chair Brad Sperling reiterated that the scale simply needs to be replaced, keeping it updated and relevant with other PRRD solid waste facilities.

The aging Chetwynd Landfill Scale is due for a replacement, having been built in the 1980s.

More Information

The PRRD's landfills accept a variety of items such as household waste, bulky waste, wood waste, metal waste, tires, concrete, and numerous other materials. However, our landfills DO NOT accept liquid waste, hazardous waste, smouldering ashes, and oil, gas, and industrial waste.

Apple and blackcurrant pancakes



Serving: 10

These pancakes are made with a whole-wheat batter and are filled with a delicious fruit mixture.

INGREDIENTS:

- 115 g (4 oz) / 250 ml (1 cup) plain whole-meal flour
- 300 ml (1/2 pint) / 300 ml (1 1/4 cups) skimmed milk
- 1 egg, beaten
- 15 ml (1 tbsp) sunflower oil, plus extra for greasing
- Half-fat crème fraîche, to serve (optional)
- Toasted nuts or sesame seeds, for sprinkling (optional)

Filling:

- 450 g (1 lb) cooking apples
- 225 g (8 oz) blackcurrants
- 30-45 ml (2-3 tbsp) water
- 30 ml (2 tbsp) demerara sugar

DIRECTIONS: To make the pancake batter, put the flour in a mixing bowl and make a well in the centre. Add a little of the milk with the egg and the oil. Beat the flour into the liquid, then gradually beat in the rest of the milk, keeping the batter smooth and free from lumps. Cover the batter and chill while you prepare the filling. Quarter, peel and core the apples. Slice them into a pan and add the blackcurrants and water. Cook over a gentle heat for 10-15 minutes until the fruit is soft. Stir in enough demerara sugar to sweeten. Lightly grease a non-stick pan with just a smear of oil. Heat the pan, pour in about 30 ml (2 tbsp) of the batter, swirl it around and cook for about 1 minute. Flip the pancake over with a palette knife and cook the other side. Put on a sheet of kitchen paper and keep hot while cooking the remaining pancakes. Fill the pancakes with the apple and blackcurrant mixture and roll them up. Serve with a dollop of crème fraîche, if using, and sprinkle with nuts or sesame seeds, if liked.

Helping Farmers Maintain Farm Status

The Government of British Columbia is waiving minimum income requirements for existing B.C. farm operations, allowing them to maintain their current property tax farm status for 2021.

"Our government is committed to helping farmers farm, and we are working to create a strong and resilient food system," said Lana Popham, Minister of Agriculture. "It's been a difficult year for many people, and this change is just one more example of how we are recognizing the challenges and supporting farmers."

The COVID-19 pandemic has been challenging for some B.C. farm operations, including smaller-scale farms that depend on roadside stands, farm markets and public interaction for sales revenue. Without this action, a number of properties would have been in jeopardy of losing farm status for the 2021 tax year, significantly increasing the property tax burden on those farmers and farm families.

"We know that robust and healthy farm operations will play an important role as we restart our economy," said Selina Robinson, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing. "Our government is committed to helping farmers maintain their farm classification for 2021 to ensure they can produce the food people in B.C. rely on."

In order to be classified as a farm in British Columbia, properties must meet certain criteria, including generating a minimum amount of gross income from a qualifying agriculture use based on the size of the parcel of land. This minimum income requirement must be met every two years and there must be some income generated every year. BC Assessment sends out self-reporting income questionnaires and conducts intermittent inspections to determine whether a property should maintain its farm status for the upcoming tax year.

This approach aligns with the Province's COVID-19 Action Plan to support businesses through the pandemic, as well as government's commitment to encourage agricultural production.

Quick Facts:

New applications for farm class and retired farmer designations will be processed as usual by BC Assessment.

Any property subject to a legal change, including a change in ownership or subdivision, and any property with a change in use or where a lease is expiring, will be required to complete a self-reporting questionnaire and will not automatically be granted farm status for 2021.

**Seven tips for keeping mosquitoes at bay
when you're camping**



We all love camping. Mosquitoes, not so much! Do you think that you can't have one without the other? Well, these tips will help you avoid being attacked by a horde of bloodthirsty insects so that you can finally enjoy your time in the great outdoors.

1. Be sure there aren't any holes or tears in your tent's fabric, and keep it zipped shut at all times.
2. Choose a campsite surrounded by deciduous trees rather than conifers.
3. Pitch your tent in an area that has a nice breeze and is far away from any standing water, electrical posts and toilets.
4. Avoid entering and leaving your tent frequently and don't leave its flap unzipped unless it's really necessary — you should also take off your shoes and turn off your flashlight before entering the tent (you can place a tarp near the entrance for your shoes).
5. Light a fire before the sun sets (the smoke will chase away the mosquitoes).
6. Arm yourself with a good bug spray or other insect-repellent product.
7. Wear long shirts and pants in light colours.

Eye on Hawkweeds

How to Recognize Invasive Hawkweeds:

Yellow Hawkweed flowers look similar to dandelions, hawksbeard, goat's beard, and sow thistles. To know if the plant is an invasive Hawkweed, watch for these important differences:

-  These yellow flowers grow in clusters at the top of a single, unbranched stem.
-  The stems contain a milky fluid and are covered in black hairs.
-  Invasive Hawkweed leaves are found at the base of the stem. Native hawkweeds have true leaves all the way up the stems.
-  If it has orange flowers clustered at the top of a single, unbranched, hairy stem, it is orange hawkweed.

Housing Needs Assessment

**Take the Housing Needs Assessment Survey -
Now extended until Sunday, August 9th!**

As part of the Housing Needs Assessment, the Peace River Regional District and partnering municipalities will be engaging with residents to get their perspectives and experiences with housing in the PRRD.



A survey is available from July 15 - **August 9th** online. Residents will also be able to request a paper copy be mailed to their home by calling 250-784-3200.

The housing needs reports will support communities in understanding current and anticipated housing needs and inform future policy decisions. Through this process, we will look at:

- **Population trends** (Who is living in our communities? How fast is the population increasing?)
- **Affordability** (How much does it cost to live here and who is this affordable for?)
- **Housing types and supports** (Is the existing housing stock meeting needs, and if not, what types of housing are needed?)
- **Future demand** (Who will live here in the future, where will they live, and in what types of housing will they live in?)

Rose Prairie Water Station Update

After reviewing a number of options for the Rose Prairie Water Station, the Peace River Regional District will be trying out Granular Activated Carbon (GAC) Filters at the Rose Prairie Water Station. The GAC unit is expected to arrive August 17th and, once it is in place, it is estimated that the pilot project will run for 4-6 weeks.



The GAC Filters will be installed at the Rose Prairie Water Station over the summer, during which time the water will continue to be tested to ensure the new filters are working as expected. The pilot study for the GAC Filters will be installed on the Bottle Fill, with the commissioning and opening of the Bottle Fill planned to take place late August/early September at the earliest.

We want to thank residents once again for their patience throughout this project. The Staff and Directors at the PRRD are looking forward to seeing the Rose Prairie Water Station fully operational and serving the residents of Electoral Area B in 2020.
