SITE C PROTESTERS VOW TO IGNORE HYDRO EVICTION NOTICE

A small number of protesters trying to halt the Site C dam by occupying land near the dam's construction site say they aren't going away anytime soon.

Peace FM spoke with two resident loggers who are working for contractors at the Site C logging site near Fort St. John yesterday, who said that protestors remain at the location.

Both loggers were told to leave the active logging area immediately and to not return until the issue was resolved. One logger added that protestors identified themselves as Treaty 8 First Nations, as well as members of other local groups.

Chetwynd resident and Sauleau First Nation member Yvonne Tupper told CBC News that "Site C is infringing our treaty rights. No Treaty 8 First Nation has ever given consent prior to construction. And it's an insult and an assault to continue construction while there are pending court cases."

Tupper says local Treaty 8 First Nations set up the protest camp in late December, with help from local ranchers and supporters, on traditional lands at Old Fort camp, on the south bank of the Peace River near the confluence with the Moberly River.

Verena Hofmann, a resident protestor, spoke with Peace FM last night and said that the protestors will continue to walk in to protest at the site known as Rocky Mountain Fort tomorrow.

The bush camp is a half hour hike from a newly-built temporary Site C bridge. Protesters say the camp has neither cell service nor road access. Tupper says she hikes in from a rough back road. She says protestors are keeping warm in the bitter cold with wood fires, while sleeping in tents, lean-tos, and a hand-built trailer.

BC Hydro, who filed a 24-hour eviction notice to leave the area on December 31st, was contacted and were made aware of the situation but has yet to offer a response to queries.

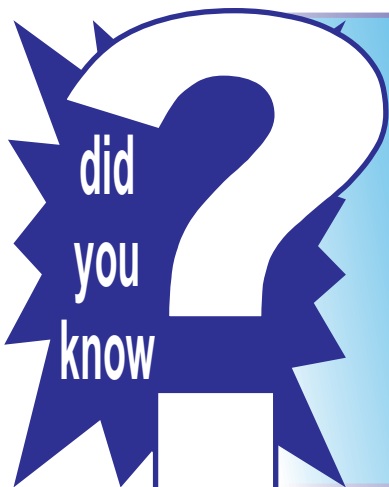

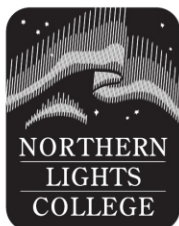
