Surerus Place held an open house this past Wednesday, September 20th and welcomed the public to come check out all their great features offered at both of their housing developments. I spoke with Melyssa Reyland, Surerus's Site Manager, about the great amenities offered.

At Surerus Place, seniors have the option of independent living or supported living - 7 units are for residents looking for independent supported housing and 5 units offer assisted living. Residents have the chance to live independently while still having services provided to them in their monthly rent, including weekly housekeeping, 24 hour lifeline emergency response, daily lunch and dinner, as well as the option to join other residents in the common areas. Surerus Place also offers weekly activities for residents of both Surerus and Little Prairie Haven to participate in, if they choose to do so.

Little Prairie Haven is for generally more mobile seniors and offers a more independent living model. They offer free laundry, maintenance of grounds and sidewalks and general repairs, as well as the use of the common area, all included in Little Prairie Haven's monthly rent.

I spoke with a few residents of Surerus Place to see how they feel about their home.

Annette Guillet, who has been a resident from the second day it was open says, "I love it here! Good food, good cleaners and we have a great manager."

Gladys Whiting has been a resident for over 5 years and she says her favourite thing is having a safe home.

Bea Kurjata has been a resident of Surerus Place for 2 or 3 years and says "It's a good place to

live, everyone has independence, but I still get my health care responsibilities set up and taken care of for me."







BCUC RELEASES PRELIMINARY REPORT INTO SITE C

Much of the report outlined areas where the commission required more information for the final report slated for release on November 1st. The report does confirm the Site C construction project is on time. The report says they have insufficient information to comment on whether or not the project will finish on its proposed budget of 8.3 billion. The report also says there's significant variance between the costs provided by BC Hydro and the Deliotte report, which suggests suspending the Site C project altogether.

In all, the BCUC report posed over 70-follow-up questions to BC Hydro, which has until October 4th to respond. Courtesy of Peace FM

NEB ISSUES 3 ORDERS TO ENBRIDGE

National Energy Board inspectors have issued three orders in Chetwynd relating to violations during construction of the High Pine Expansion Project.

The inspection officer orders will target Enbridge and are for failing to adhere to worker safety, pipe handling and environmental protection requirements.

The pipeline in question is responsible for moving nearly 240 million cubic feet of natural gas to the south and Unite States each day.

The issues stem from a number of safety concerns discovered during three separate inspections, two in late August, and one on September 13th.

BEETLE INFESTATION IN PRINCE GEORGE
