When Life Takes You Down, You Learn To Always Look Up!

Just over a month ago, I experienced something that rocked my life, both physically and mentally. I was out in the bush getting firewood and had the top 10' of a 70+' cottonwood tree brake off and fell on me, my two nephews, niece and daughter.... Yeah 5 people! We were all lucky enough to not get badly hurt, but it sure gets your brain thinking! How is it that five people can ALL be in the wrong place at the wrong time. I was struggling with that fact that we were so lucky, but also so unlucky! To have a tree fall on your head from that far in the air and not even get a concussion, I had my guardian angels working hard that day. This has given me even more of a zest for life and everything it has to offer, and has also made me appreciate my health exponentially!

But along with the positive thinking this experience has helped me gain, this event has also brought to my attention the enormous amount of dead, near dead and completely rotted out trees in our area. And frankly, has made me nervous that this could happen to someone else!

With the wind in our area, watching out for falling trees and branches should be something everyone is constantly doing, but as humans we get complacent. Sometimes even trees in our own yards can be a hazard. Here are some ways to spot troublesome and dangerous trees from landing on your house, vehicle or heaven forbid, your family!

A hole in the trunk. A cavity can form in the trunk of a tree when the tree prunes itself by dropping a branch. That can lead to decay inside the tree. This doesn't always mean danger, though. If there's enough sound wood around the cavity, the tree probably won't fall.

Missing bark or deep cracks. An area where tree bark is missing, gashed or indented is called a "canker." A canker can make a tree more likely to break at that spot, even if the wood looks OK. Deep cracks in bark are a bad sign, too.

Dead or falling branches. When trees start dropping bits of branches or entire branches, it's a clue that something's wrong- the tree is trying to make itself smaller so there's not as much to feed. And dead branches are a major danger — they can come crashing down even on a calm day.

Leaning trunk. A tree that's leaning more than 15 degrees due to wind or root damage usually needs to be removed. A tree that's naturally tilted because it grew that way isn't as risky.

Losing leaves from the outside in. When a tree loses leaves in this pattern often it means something is wrong with the root zone. The root zone is where the tree gets nutrients and water — and it's what holds the tree up, without a healthy root system, a tree can fall more easily.

Rotten roots. Root rot can be hard to spot. Look for mushrooms growing around the base of a tree. Fungi growing on the trunk can be another clue that the tree is rotting inside.

Tight branch growth. When branches grow close together in a V-shape, it's a bad sign. A strong union will be U-shaped. Elm, maple, oak, yellow poplar and willow trees tend to break at weak forks. When the wind blows, those trees can fall apart. This problem is easiest to spot in winter after the leaves have fallen off

This article is not intended to scare anyone or to bring fear to enjoying our outdoors, but to remind everyone. That although rare, things like this happen and my family was unlucky enough to be in the

wrong place, wrong time, but lucky enough to

walk away with a story to tell!


