# A Few Tips to Help Handle the Stresses of Caregiving

Managing the care of a loved one who has physical, cognitive or mental health challenges is the reality for more than 8.1 million Canadians who are unpaid caregivers. Overwhelmed by the magnitude of the daily decisions they have to make, many feel an enormous burden of providing support while struggling to keep their own lives on track.

According to the Canadian Carers Pulse Survey, 69 per cent of respondents reveal that caregiving has taken a toll on their emotional health, while more than half said it affects their physical health.

If you provide care to a loved one, here are some tips on reducing your stress:

**Ask for help.** Caregiving is stressful, and you don't have to do it alone. Connect with your loved one's healthcare team and don't be afraid to ask questions and request information. Talk to your pharmacist. New continuing education programs and resources are helping pharmacists provide tailored services to the caregivers in their community. For example, the new Caregiver Friendly Pharmacy Program was specifically developed to support caregivers and is now available to pharmacies across Canada.



**Get organized.** Websites like tevacaregivers.com provide tools and checklists to help you organize and update key information about your loved one's condition.

Take care of yourself. Take the caregiver selfassessment to determine if you need help from a health care provider.

Learn what caregiver resources are available. Some of these are national and provincial government resources, support organizations, patient groups and health and social services centres.

# Why do cats rub their faces on everything?

Have you ever wondered why cats rub their faces on seemingly everything they cross paths with? This behaviour is called bunting, and it's actually a form of feline communication. However, depending on what they rub themselves on, it can have different meanings.

Cats have scent glands located in their feet, below their chin, on their lips, near their temples, along their tails and in their ears. These glands release pheromones, which cats use to mark their territory. If a cat rubs itself all over your furniture and walls, it's saying that those things are the property of kittv.

Bunting may be a show of dominance

over other felines in the house, or it may be a way for the cat to feel more comfortable



If your kitty doesn't like to show their face when you have visitors, they may rub their scent around the house once the strangers have gone. Bunting allows them to reclaim the house and feel calmer.

But what about when a cat rubs itself on you? Do they consider you their property as well? The answer depends on your relationship with the kitty in question.

Cats often rub themselves on newcomers to their home. If they do this, it's to gather the intruder's scent and find out more about them. However, if they bunt against their human companions, it's a sign of affection and that they consider you a part of their family.


