DAWSON CREEK YOUTH CRIME SPREE

On July 5, 2016 at 7:55 a.m. the Dawson Creek RCMP received a report of an erratic driver of a Commercial Tractor Trailer unit inside the city limits of Dawson Creek.

Police were initially able to locate the vehicle, but it failed to stop for police and was not pursued for public safety reasons, but moments later the truck was spotted at a red light by an officer in an unmarked police vehicle. The officer pulled in front of the Semi-Tractor and was able to take the driver, a 13 year old youth and his 16 year old female passenger into custody.

Investigation revealed that the two went on a bit of an alleged crime spree, allegedly stealing a pickup truck in Dawson Creek, travelling to Chetwynd where they crashed the truck. The two youths then allegedly stole a side by side ATV and drove to another location in Chetwynd where they allegedly stole the tractor and trailer Unit.

The pair are being held in custody pending a bail hearing to answer to a number of recommended charges including theft over, possession of stolen property over, dangerous driving, and flight from police.





like ours remain accessible and connected" said Bernier. "This funding will benefit businesses, visitors and all residents".

"The Government of British Columbia recognizes the importance of having a strong provincial transportation system. This was evident with the introduction last year of the British Columbia Air Access Program which identified the need to assist communities with their airport infrastructure.", said Airport Manager Ian Darling. "The British Columbia Air Access Program is ground breaking and has shown its importance in keeping B.C. connected. We are looking forward to many years of continued success."

Through the B.C. Air Access Program, the government shares cost with public airports on development projects. These types of projects will allow airports to improve safety, accommodate larger aircraft and more frequent flights, and further support the continuing growth of local and provincial economies.

The government is investing \$24 million over three years for the B.C. Air Access Program.

The program also encourages funding partnerships with the federal government, local and regional governments and agencies, and the private sector. Last year, the program provided just over \$6 million towards improvements at ten regional airports across the province.

B.C. On the Move is government's 10-year plan for the improvement of the province's transportation network. Over the next three years, the B.C. government will invest almost \$2.7 billion in transportation improvements.

DISASTER FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WILL NOT BE **DELAYED DUE TO** CANADA POST

The government of BC announced today that there will be no delay for those receiving disaster financial assistance due to the floods that crushed the Peace River region.

The province will work with the Regional District, and ditch the usual cheque delivered by mail and will instead deliver them directly to local authority who will then arrange for delivery. In Dawson Creek, city staff will handdeliver the cheques to residents.

As of today, there have been 144 applications for disaster financial assistance from residents in the Peace River Regional District. There has been \$70,000 in payments made so far. The deadline to submit a claim does not close until September 15, 2016.

Disaster Financial Assistance (DFA) has been authorized for Dawson Creek, Chetwynd, Fort St. John, Hudson's Hope, Peace Coupe, Taylor, Tumbler Ridge, as well as the first nations communities of Saulteau and West Moberly.
