Anti Vaxxers Beware, Mandatory Vaccinations Cross Province for Students B.C. Health Minister Adrian Dix says the province will require parents to register their children's

B.C. Health Minister Adrian Dix says the province will require parents to register their children's immunization records at school by the fall, with all students in both public and private schools required to provide proof of up to date immunizations.

The main goal of vaccination registration is to provide education to parents about vaccines and how they have been proven successful in eradicating diseases.

More than 6000 suspension orders will go out to students in Waterloo, Ontario over vaccines. Parents will have until March 26 to provide proof of immunization or a valid exemption to avoid suspension, which can last up to 20 days. Dix has said B.C.'s model will closely follow Ontario's immunization program for children attending school.

This is what B.C. parents can expect when mandatory immunization reporting takes effect:

- Before the school year begins, parents will need to gather their child's immunization records either from their physician or public health.
- Immunization records will be submitted to the school, likely with the usual registration records as the school year begins. That information will be forwarded to public health and entered into the registry.
- If a particular immunization is missing, parents will be advised to follow up with their public health unit or physician to get their child up to date.
- There will likely be a grace period for students who are not caught up with their required immunizations.
- If a parent wants their child exempt based on their personal beliefs, they will require a notarized form
 that outlines that parents understand the potential consequences of their child not being immunized.
- Exemptions will likely be allowed for valid medical reasons, like allergic reactions, and those will be reviewed by a medical health officer.
- Suspensions for non-compliance are likely.

Basically, exemptions will exist for children who cannot receive vaccines due to medical reasons. If a parent does not want a child to receive an immunization because of "philosophical reasons", Dix says they "would have to go through a process to state that."

Recently, B.C. has seen a substantial increase in the number of people who have been vaccinated. There have been13 confirmed cases of measles reported so far in this outbreak in Vancouver. But fortunately this actually is a small fraction compared to other recent measles outbreaks including the

343 reported cases in 2014 and another 87 cases in 2010.
