SAFER ROADS GOAL OF NEW FOCUS ON DANGEROUS DRIVERS

Street racers and other dangerous drivers will spend longer away from the wheel – making roads safer for everyone else – as B.C. begins tailoring prohibitions to better deter certain serious driving behaviours.

"The drivers posing the greatest risk to people's lives are often caught repeatedly, and that tells us they aren't taking the consequences seriously," said Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General Mike Farnworth. "We're going to be scrutinizing their driving more closely and making sure the penalty fits. Racers who won't take their cars to the track can expect to walk or use public transit."

Effective Dec. 1, 2017, longer prohibitions will replace the existing 15-day penalties for street racing and stunt driving. The prohibitions can also apply to a broader range of offences, including excessive speeding, driving without due care and attention and other high-risk driving behaviours that present an immediate risk to public safety.

RoadSafetyBC will set the length of each prohibition based on the incident details provided by the police, as well as the driver's record, with most prohibitions generally between three and 36 months in length. Drivers will be able to request a review of their case through an adjudication process that RoadSafetyBC already uses when drivers appeal prohibitions under the Driver Improvement Program.

"When RoadSafetyBC intervenes, high-risk drivers typically face longer suspensions and additional remedial measures," said Neil Dubord, chief constable, chair of the B.C. Association of Chiefs of Police Traffic Safety Committee. "We were consulted on the new approach and believe it will make B.C.'s roads safer."

Police will still be able to immediately impound vehicles for a minimum of seven

days if drivers are caught street racing or stunt driving.



MAYOR'S REPORT

December 1, 2017

I skipped a week in writing this column and asked Councillor Clay to share with you his passion on mental health. I appreciate that other members of Council are able to write on topics from which I draw back but which are very important to the health and well being of our community.

You may have heard (I hope you have heard) that Chetwynd is among the thirty most charming communities in Canada. When I read this I had to reflect on the reasons. Without apology, I can affirm that much of the background for this designation rests with your six Council members. They are a dedicated, idea body, eyes and ears always tuned to the pulse of the community. What a committed group who, not always seeing eye to eye, still listen to each other and respect the decisions of the body!

These last two weeks I have been ill and unable to function in my office. Fact is, nobody would have willingly tolerated my presence. That said, I can also affirm that I fully support the decisions made by Council in my absence. But it is good to be coming back from the brink of the abyss. (Some of you know what it's like – probably many of you. Realistically, you know that the present illness likely is not the one that will put you under – you just wish it would release you from your misery.)

Let me share with you some of the good things that are happening in our home town. Indeed, life and work continue apace in spite of the absence of the Mayor. It helps me realize that I am not indispensible – a humbling but essential concept for any Mayor. You can get along without my hovering over your shoulders. As it should be!

Work camps in town that generated so much interest and discussion earlier this fall are now actually serving the workers. I think your Council made the right decision in limiting the term to one year with the first permit. While full now, as are the regular rental facilities, twelve months down the road will allow us clearer vision of conditions at that time. New decisions can be made consistent with the changing work and occupancy environment.

Your recycling habits are an encouragement to those who believe in recycling. Both blue-bag pilot projects (Crown Sub and Rodeo Grounds) are turning in respectable quantities of materials that formerly ended in the landfill.

Chetwynd's relationship with Conuma Coal reached a new level in November. A number of months ago, Chetwynd and Conuma came to an agreement that would see Chetwynd's receiving a monthly contribution from Conuma in recognition of Conuma's strong dependence on the community for workers and services. The first of these contributions arrived on November 21. As Conuma prospers, so Chetwynd also prospers. It is a good and healthy relationship. Long may it thrive! How will the funds be used? For the time being, Council has directed that they be placed in a reserve against future needs and good ideas.

New businesses in town are always encouraging. For years I have advocated for a car dealership. It's here. Located in the former carwash facility down the street from Tim Horton's and behind Duz Cho, you won't have any trouble finding it. Long may it thrive!

In other work, construction has begun on the new water treatment plant expected to be completed within four months. During the construction period residents should not experience any changes in the way water is delivered. While restrictions are imposed on commercial haulers, all rural residents will continue to be served.

That's about it for this update. We continue to appreciate the way outside workers rise to the challenge of keeping our streets serviceable during the heavy snow we are experiencing. Thanks to all of you who work to keep our community safe and functional. *Merlin Nichols, Mayor*

VACANCY NUMBERS DROP IN PEACE'S BIGGEST CITIES

A new report by the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation has yielded some interesting results for the Peace's two biggest cities

The report, which took an in depth look in to vacancy rates and rental costs, showed a sizeable drop in vacancies in both Fort St John and Dawson Creek, compared to a year ago.

According to the report, Fort St John currently faces a vacancy rate of 18.5 percent, down from the 28.8 percent from a year ago.

The drop in Fort St John can likely be accredited to a drop in average rental rates by about \$40/month, as well as the last report being skewed due to unusual population fluctuation.

The more interesting report comes out of Dawson Creek, where the city saw a drop of nearly 8 percent, to 11.8 percent, despite rent costs actually rising.

The average rental rate in Dawson Creek sits at \$989/month, a \$28 raise over last year, and \$14 increase when compared to Fort St John.

Across the province, the monthly rent rate jumped 5.3 percent, while vacancy rates sit at 1.3 percent.
