WILDFIRE SMOKE ADVISORY ISSUED FOR FORT ST JOHN

On July 09, 2015, The Ministry of Environment has issued a Smoke Advisory for Fort St. John and surrounding areas because of wildfire smoke that is affecting the region. Smoke concentrations will vary widely as winds, fire behaviour and temperatures change. This situation is expected to persist until meteorological conditions change.

If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms, contact your health care provider: difficulty in breathing, chest pain or discomfort, and sudden onset of cough or irritation of airways. If you are experiencing symptoms, avoid strenuous outdoor activities, especially along busy traffic corridors. Exposure is particularly a concern for infants, the elderly and those who have underlying medical conditions such as diabetes, and lung or heart disease.

Tips to reduce your personal health risk:

- ~ People with heart or lung conditions may be more sensitive to the effects of smoke and should watch for any change in symptoms that may be due to smoke exposure. If any symptoms are noted, affected individuals should take steps to reduce their exposure to smoke and if necessary see their physician. People with symptoms should go to their health care provider, walk in clinic or emergency department depending on severity of symptoms.
- ~ Use common sense regarding outdoor physical activity if your breathing becomes difficult or uncomfortable, stop or reduce the activity.
- ~ Stay cool and drink plenty of fluids.
- ~ Smoke levels may be lower indoors, however levels of smoke particles will still be increased. If you stay indoors, be aware of your symptoms.
- ~ Consider visiting a location like a shopping mall with cooler filtered air. Keep in

mind that staying indoors may help you stay cool and provide some relief



DAWSON CREEK MEDIA RELEASE

Dawson Creek RCMP responded to 227 calls for service during the week of June 28th 2015, to July 4th 2015. Included in the calls for service were 25 driving complaints, 9 collisions, 9 alcohol related driving investigations, 19 theft investigations, and 8 break and enters.

Police are warning citizens about ongoing phone fraud scams that are occurring in the area again. Caller will advise that one of the victims family members has been in a serious accident and the victim needs to send money for medical costs. Police are warning the public that any phone calls like this should be verified prior to money being sent as it is highly unlikely that Canadian medical institutions will call seeking money from family members. Simple questions such as asking for the name of the hospital where the person is being treated will often stop these types of frauds in their tracks. Police advise that you should never provide banking information to a person who has called you, rather you should advise that you will contact the agency in question yourself to verify the information.

On June 29th 2015, Police responded to a complaint of break, enter and theft of heavy equipment. Thieves smashed through the gate of Melbern Vegetation and stole a trailer with a CAT skid steer and mower attachment. The theft occurred in the Vic Turner industrial area near the Dawson Creek airport. Police are asking for the public's assistance in this matter. Anyone who may have witnessed a truck and trailer with the skid steer leaving the area during the night of June 28th and early morning hours of June 29th is asked to contact police.



from the smoke, however many air conditioning systems do not filter the air or improve indoor air quality.

- ~ Reduce indoor pollution sources such as smoking or burning other materials.
- ~ You may be able to reduce your exposure to smoke by moving to cleaner air. Conditions can vary dramatically by area and elevation.
- ~ Residents with asthma or other chronic illness should activate their asthma or personal care plan.
- ~ Pay attention to local air quality reports, air quality may be poor even though smoke may not

be visible.

- ~ Commercially available HEPA (high efficiency particulate air) filters can further reduce poor indoor air quality near the device.
- ~ Maintaining good overall health is a good way to prevent health effects resulting from short-term exposure to air pollution.
