FIRST NATIONS GROUPS CHALLENGE SIT **C DAM CONSTRUCTION**

Prophet River First Nation and West Moberly First Nations submitted a petition against the construction of Site C dam which started recently. The petition was submitted to the Supreme Court of British Columbia.

BC Hydro, the Minister of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations, the Regional Manager and Regional Water Manager of the Northeast Region, and the Chief Inspector of Mines are all named in the petition.




