#### HYDRO COMPLETES BENNETT DAM UPGRADES, NDP LAUNCHES NEW ENERGY PLAN

Five generating units at the WAC Bennett Dam's GM Shrum Generating Station have been renovated at a cost of \$272 million, about \$100 million under budget.

The Crown Corporation says these refurbishments make the units more efficient, and allow the facility to use the same amount of water as before to generate more power. Energy & Mines Minister Bill Bennett said these upgrades will power an additional 16,000 homes. With the completion of this most recent project, BC Hydro has now made significant upgrades to eight of the facility's 10 units.


Meanwhile NDP leader John Horgan announced the launch of that party's PowerBC plan, which they say is a complete revamp of the province's energy policy.

The program proposes to create jobs in every community in the province, while also scuppering the Site C project in favour of other upgrades across BC Hydro's existing infrastructure, including the installation of the sixth and final generator at the Revelstoke Dam. They say the addition of Unit 6 would add 500 MW of energy capacity at a cost of \$420 million, compared to the reported \$8.3 billion cost of Site C. The NDP continued, saying that many hydroelectric dams across BC are operating '50's-era machinery.'

Horgan says that the plan would free BC Hydro to pursue clean energy potential in wind, solar and other emerging technologies. The plan also includes a push for local procurement and local hiring. Energy Minister Bill Bennett criticized the plan, saying the NDP has offered nothing new after two years of constructing the plan, and that the plan to upgrade the Revelstoke Dam is already in the works.

The NDP had remained ambiguous on their stance with regard to Site C until Motion 19 to continue Site C construction was debated by the provincial legislature in early October, when NDP



The Tumbler Ridge Global Geopark Society (TRGGS) is excited to share the news issued by UNESCO announcing that all 120 existing Global Geoparks, including the TRGGS, will now officially become UNESCO sites. The announcements come after the 195 Member States of UNESCO voted positively to create the UNESCO Global Geoparks Network, supporting the initiative to promote national geological heritage initiatives. UNESCO Global Geoparks have now joined World Heritage sites and Biosphere Reserves as an official UNESCO program under this formalization of the relationship between UNESCO and the Global Geoparks. For Canada, this means that both Tumbler Ridge Global Geopark and the Stonehammer Geopark will now be recognized as UNESCO Global Geopark sites.




