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CHETWYND COUNCIL MEETING

The monthly meeting of the District of Chetwynd took place at 4:30 p.m. on the 14th of August, 2017 at the District of Chetwynd Municipal Office Council Chambers with all Councillors and the Mayor present.

Niki Hedges of the United Way of Northern British Columbia invited Council to participate and attract new corporations to contribute to United Way. She said that the United Way in Chetwynd supported child learning activities at Tansi Friendship Centre and the Chetwynd Public Library.

Carmen Westgate of the Chainsaw Carving Society reported a very successful chainsaw competition this year. Councillor Weisgerber congratulated the committee on a well done job. The Mayor congratulated Westgate and her committee for having a surplus. A complete accounting is in the agenda of the District of Chetwynd.

Correspondence include a thank you from the Ministry of Community, Sport and Cultural Development for the donation of a chainsaw caring to the Ministry.

A funding request of \$1200 for Executive Director Naomi Larsen to attend the Business to Business (B2B Expo) in Dawson Creek and the BC Chamber Executives 2017 Conference in Invermere BC was passed with at a total cost of \$1200 allocated. Council said that the business community would benefit.

A Temporary Use Permit Application from Dave Milner was received for the purpose of temporarily locating a 300-person work camp at 4414-44th Avenue in the Industrial Grounds. It was passed but a discussion ensued about the three year tenure.

Approval to place chainsaw carvings in Mackenzie, at the Dawson Creek Airport and at the Saulteau First Nations, Peace Christian School and the West Moberly First Nations was passed, along with approval to repair and rebuild the tennis courts with a cost of \$40,000 by Councillor Pfanner.

A Temporary Use Permit Application from the Black Diamond Group to allow a 266-person work camp at 4300 - 46th Drive Northeast was passed. Discussion of kitchen facilities was brought up in this matter.

A request to Council for consideration of a Development Permit from Carmen Westgate dba Brookwood Properties to permit recreational vehicles and campers to locate temporarily at 4800 53rd Street was passed. Westgate said that about 15 recreational spaces will be available.

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MEET THE MAYOR August 18, 2017

Last time I wrote I had just returned from a drive about town having been duly impressed with the town we have made and are making. Once again on my first day back I am impressed with our home town but this time after a drive about central North America – Kentucky, Ohio, Indiana, and Michigan. For some reason, probably known only to geographers, one can hit all four states and still have some daylight left. But only if one does not get too hopelessly lost in the maze of interconnecting, intersecting, and parallel means of getting somewhere.

So it's good to be home in my comfort zone where I feel safe and where I know the ways and means of getting where I want to go.

It's also good to come home to solid evidence that the business of the community goes forward just as well in my absence as in my presence. It provides a certain sense of humility, that robust assurance that when I am gone I won't be missed for very long. Pity the elected official whose conceit trends the mind to other

conclusions - not that you elected any of those in the last round.

A couple of weeks ago Councillor Bassendowski brought you up to date on the various projects currently under way in Chetwynd.

Those are the major projects but more are in the offing. Administration and Staff are regularly seeking out funding sources for changes that will make Chetwynd even more liveable. That is what keeps us going, and coming also. So far we haven't reached the point at which we are no longer sure if we are coming or going.

Several events are scheduled for this fall and into the winter. On September 6 a Regional Community Liaison Committee (RCLC for those who thrive on acronyms) will meet in Fort St. John to inform us on happenings at the Site C project. Perhaps there will be some real information. That same afternoon I will participate in the unveiling of a chainsaw Sculpture in Pouce Coupe followed by a run to Tumbler Ridge to engage in the Coal Forum jointly hosted by Chetwynd and Tumbler Ridge. This event will occupy two days and is supposed to provide us with at least two days' worth of coal-mining data.

On September 20 the Business 2 Business (B2B) forum will meet in Dawson Creek. I have had to excuse myself from this one but Chetwynd will be well represented by Counsellor Galbraith. So fear not, the business knowledge will be coming back to shape our thinking.

The big event for this fall is the 2017 version of the big event that has happened every fall for the last 100+ years. The Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM) convention meets this year in Vancouver from September 25 through 29. Not all of Council is attending this year but there is enough work for all of us. We're expecting to be exhausted when we return but this is how we get to meet our counterparts from around the province and share experiences and knowledge of municipal government.

I guess I didn't get very far into the winter with this notice of events. There's time for that later. By the way, according to Oliver Wendell Holmes if "man's mind [is] once stretched by a new idea [it will] never again [regain] its original dimensions." Do be careful.
