

Under Woden's supervision, the earth and sky were created from the dead body of a giant named Ymir. Woden also created the first man and woman from an ash tree and an alder. As if fashioning the human race wasn't enough, Woden also established the laws of the universe. (The wacky history of Tuesday makes the origin of "Wednesday" seem boring.)




