TWO PEACE VALLEY GROUPS CALL HALT IN SITE C CONTRUCTION



Two Peace Valley groups have called for the provincial government to halt construction at the Site C Dam pending completion of the BC Utilities Commission inquiry into Site C. The Peace Valley Landowner Association and the Peace Valley Environment Association both say two reports by Deliotte LLP released late last week make claims to support suspension of construction. The report found that there could be a cost overrun on construction of the dam between \$1.7 and \$4.3 billion. The groups also point to recent hydroelectric dam construction projects in Manitoba and Newfoundland that had cost overruns between 55 and 90 per cent.

MAYOR'S REPORT

These last months have impressed on us the vulnerability of our position in an unpredictable world. (I guess some things are predictable in general terms but precision as to month, day, hour, and person is still very much a guess.) Last year Chetwynd and surrounding rural residential areas were hammered by the second major flood in five years; we got all psyched up this year in mid June for a flood that didn't materialize. Instead, we were left to sympathize at a distance with the folks who were, and still are, experiencing the worst wild fires in BC memory. Fire or water, we've been through it and have the personal experience of disruption and loss to prove our experience.

The recent marriage of Houston, Texas and Hurricane Harvey, stormy at best, violent, long-lasting, and likely global in effect at worst, carries potential to reach into our wallets way up here in the supposed insularity of Chetwynd. Forget your insularity. Ye don't got any. It's a global economy that we inhabit and when Houston is hammered, we feel the pain and see the bruises.

Not being a prophet, the son of a prophet, or an economist (I am eagerly awaiting the entertainment factor of the economists who are bound to wax eloquent on money matters, global trade, and the Houston effect at the Union of BC Municipalities convention in a couple of weeks.), I can only note the upstream end and the downstream end of crude-oil pipelines. The stuff that goes into the up end as crude comes out of Houston as gasoline and other combustibles. Because we inhabit a global economy, expecting higher prices at the pumps, if not real shortages, is a reasonable, if not comforting, mental exercise.

But we have our own vulnerabilities to consider. Two major floods within five years should give us pause to reflect on how to meet the next flood whenever it comes.

Some questions I will ask myself—and answer—include the following: Do I have two weeks' supply of non-perishable food stored in a place outside the reach of flood water, rodents, mildew, and other destructive elements? Ditto for clean drinking water. (Non-perishable food should include some of the staples such as dry beans and lentils, a variety of canned goods, and other stuff compatible with your own taste buds and budget.) Do I have reliable flash lights, and a generator with fuel where applicable? What about relevant insurance coverage? I'm just getting you started thinking in the right direction. Really, there will be times in which you might find yourself on your own with no one to bring you help. Will you be ready?

A deluge in the hills above our home town could cut off all transportation links for days. Store shelves could long be empty before links are reopened – supposing you can even get across town.

So, I need to ask what the District of Chetwynd can do more to reduce the effect of a major event of flood, fire, or toxic spill on the life of the community. What can we do more? There, I've just asked the question but the answers are not simple.

We can keep our stream beds free of impediments to water flow. We can build levies in strategic locations. We can ensure that the drainage systems are adequate to accommodate the expected flow. We can keep an up-to-date list of up-to-date equipment to put to work on a day's notice.

That will help the community weather moderate events such as we have already experienced. But the big one? It's up to all of us to be individually prepared.

Oh, by the way, "adversity has the effect of eliciting talents, which, in prosperous circumstances, would have lain dormant" Horace (65-8 BC).

KELSEY'S CHRONICLE



Autumn brings about a feeling that makes you long for homemade soup or pie. So, I have compiled a few recipes that will make you want to raid your garden and throw on an apron. These are a few of my personal recipes that combine simple ingredients and easy instructions.

Chicken & Vegetable Soup - 1 whole chicken or 2 large chicken thighs (bone in) - slow boil in a pot of water with half of a yellow onion. After a couple hours, take out the chicken, remove the bones, cut into bite size pieces and return to the pot. Add carrots, turnip and salt and pepper and return to a boil,

then cover and simmer. Time to add my "secret ingredients," a few squirts around the pot of ketchup and bbg sauce (2:1 ratio). Add broccoli, potatoes and zucchini. Simmer for another hour and it's good to go!

Stuffed Peppers - Brown ground beef in a pan with salt and pepper. Meanwhile, cut 3 cups of cherry tomatoes in half, add 2 cloves of garlic, salt and olive oil and broil in the oven on low for 20 minutes. Throw the beef and tomatoes together in a crock pot and mash. Add a little beef or chicken broth and keep on low in the crock pot for a few hours. In the meantime, cook 2 cups of rice and prepare several peppers for stuffing. Use a slotted spoon to separate the tomatoes and beef from the sauce and mix with the rice. Stuff the peppers with the mixture and add the rest of the sauce around the peppers, grate cheese over top and bake for 45 mins -1 hr at 350.

Zucchini Parmesan - many people have zucchini left over from the garden and are trying to get it into as many recipes as possible. This recipe usually calls for eggplant but zucchini works just as well, if not better!

Slice a large zucchini into 2 cm thick slices to create several circular shaped patties. Dip sliced zucchini in a beaten egg mixture, and then into parmesan and breadcrumbs. Place them on a cookie sheet that's been lightly oiled with olive oil. Bake at 425 for 20 minutes, flipping over once. Add a dollop of your favourite marinara sauce and a few slices of mozzarella on top of each and return to the oven for another 15-20 minutes or until cheese is bubbly and beginning to brown.

Tip: In order to keep these crispy and not soggy, use just a small amount of marinara and don't spread it around

Apple Crisp - Simple and delicious! Peel and cut apples, mix with 2 tbsp of white sugar and a sprinkle of cinnamon and spoon mixture into a 9x9 pan. In a separate bowl, use a pastry cutter to combine 3/4 cup of flour, 3/4 cup oats, 1 cup brown sugar, 1/2 cup cold butter and another sprinkle of cinnamon. Spread mixture over the apples and press, bake at 350 for 40 minutes or until golden and bubbly around the edges.

Tip: for a bit of a tangy version, try squirting the juice of a lemon into the apple mixture.


