

#### POLICE CHASE LEADS TO ARREST IN PRINCE GEORGE

A Dawson Creek woman was arrested after a chase in Prince George.

On Saturday December 10th, around 3:30 a.m., Prince George RCMP received a report of a suspicious vehicle on Otway Road.

When police arrived, the vehicle attempted to flee by going through two ditches and ramming the side of a police car, before heading west of the city. Police did not continue the pursuit, but found the abandoned vehicle in a ditch a few minutes later where they discovered the vehicle was stolen in Dawson Creek on December 5th

Nearly two hours later, a female suspect was found by a police dog hiding under a fallen tree. 34 year-old Dawson Creek resident Christina Louise Nellis, who is said to have a history in Prince George, has been charged with two counts of Failing to Comply with a Recognisance, and one count each of:

Assaulting a Peace Officer with a Weapon

Possession of Property Obtained by Crime

Flight from Police

After continuing their investigation, police deduced that a second truck had been stolen from the business where the first truck was located. That second truck was found abandoned a short distance away. Two more suspects were tracked by police dogs from the second vehicle. One suspect was tracked to another business where a third vehicle was found to have been stolen, while another female suspect was tracked to a home where she asked a resident to call a taxi.

The woman that called the taxi is described as: Caucasian, standing 5'6" tall, weighing 150 lbs., with reddish hair in a bun or ponytail. She was last seen wearing jeans, a red or maroon coat and brown boots. The third stolen pickup is described as: a white 2006 Ford F250 short box with BC licence plate DY8093.
