BC HYDRO AWARDS CONTRACT FOR SOUTH BANK CLEARING WORK FOR SITE C

BC Hydro announced Monday May 11th that it has awarded a contract for clearing the south bank of the Site C dam construction area to Paul Paquette and Son's Contracting Ltd. The Site C clearing work on the south bank is required to prepare the dam site for construction. This contract will provide approximately 40 jobs and includes:

- Removal of 620 hectares of trees and vegetation
- Construction of up to 30 kilometres of temporary access roads and associated landings
- Upgrading and maintaining an existing access road
- Collection and deposition of waste wood, as required
- Site preparation for bridge construction

The contract with Paul Paquette and Son's Contracting meets key procurement objectives including being within budget — as well as requirements related to safety, quality and production.

Based in Chetwynd, Paul Paquette and Son's Contracting is supported by four other local companies based in the Chetwynd area — Young's Mills (1980) Ltd., B.A.C.K. Ventures, Hi-Sky Enterprises Ltd. and Hustle Contracting Ltd. The combined annual production capacity of the five contractors exceeds 1.4MMm3.

The contract for clearing the south bank of the dam site is one of several BC Hydro procurements for the Site C project. On April 30, BC Hydro announced that Two Rivers Lodging Group has been selected as the preferred proponent for the Site C Worker Accommodation contract. Other procurements underway include: Site Preparation - North Bank, Main Civil Works, and Turbines and Generators.

Construction of the Site C Clean Energy Project is scheduled to start in summer 2015 and be completed in 2024. Once built, Site C will provide clean, reliable and affordable electricity in B.C.

BUTANE LEAK AT SPECTRA ENERGY'S MCMAHON PLANT FORCES EVACUATION

The national energy board is investigating the butane leak at Spectra Energy's Mcmahon plant in Taylor. At approximately 2:30 p.m. Saturday May 9th, residents of South West Taylor were advised to evacuate after a butane gas leak was reported by Spectra Energy.

The incident is now under control, but as a precaution, an evacuation of South West Taylor, an area of approximately three blocks by four blocks, was initiated by the Taylor Fire Department and the RCMP. As well, the Alaska Highway was closed in both directions.

The emergency response team from Spectra had the leak fully contained by 3:50 pm. By 3:56 pm air quality testing indicated that there were no remnants of the product left in the air and the evacuation was called off. The Alaska Highway was reopened and evacuated residents were allowed back home.

While the incident is under the jurisdiction of the National Energy Board, staff from the BC Oil and Gas Commission are on site on behalf of the NEB, as part of an agreement that the NEB has with the BCOGC.

The NEB says all appropriate agencies have been notified and an NEB investigation into the cause of the incident is underway. The NEB's job is to hold regulated companies fully responsible and accountable for responding in a manner that protects the public, property and the environment.



DAWSON CREEK FIREFIGHTERS CONTAIN GAS LINE RUPTURE

Dawson Creek Firefighters were on the scene of a large natural gas leak the afternoon of Friday May 10th, after crews working on a housing development ruptured an underground pipe.

The construction workers were digging between two unfinished houses on 17th Street when an excavator struck the high pressure gas line, which crews described as sounding like a jet engine.

Fire fighters arrived by around 12:30, while Pacific Northern Gas (PNG) Employees shut off the line and stopped the flow of gas.

Deputy Fire Chief Bob Fulton was not clear how much gas escaped, but said the biggest fear was the potential for the gas to ignite. He

"I shouldn't say good morning or anything?" the daughter asked.


"Not a word," her mother affirmed.


