### DISTRICT OF CHETWYND COULD SEE REFERENDUM OVER SEWER UPGRADES

The District of Chetwynd held its regularly scheduled council meeting on April 20th. Councillors Mel Deck, Ernest Pfanner and Laura Weisgerber were absent.

One item of business was the District of Chetwynd bylaw to borrow \$1.5 million dollars to construct and to improve the sewage treatment plant. If voters wish to oppose the borrowing of the funds to reconstruct the sewerage treatment plant, they will have until June 1st to sign a petition. If 10 per cent of the registered voters sign the Petition, the borrowing of the funds will have to go to referendum. An open house will be held at the District Office Council Chambers on May 4th to discuss the sewer project.

The District also discussed the possibility of assisting the Pine Valley Exhibition with improvements of the PVEP parking lot and roads. The PVEP is requesting that the parking lot and surrounding roads be improved by grading and adding gravel with the use of the District of Chetwynd equipment and employees. The budget for said improvement was discussed but no price has been estimated at this moment.

Spectra Energy made a presentation to the District. They touched upon their Jackfish Lake Expansion, which is a natural gas pipeline being constructed from Taylor to Chetwynd. They expansion is said to take place will into 2017.

The top 5 chainsaw carvings that were voted upon at the Chetwynd Trade Show are to be relocated at the New Municipal Hall. The winning carvings are: Building Character, BC Bench, Welcoming the Spirits, Little Giant and Killing Time.

Last, The Chetwynd Midget Hockey Giants team thanked the Mayor and Council for sponsoring the team during the provincial championships. The Giants capped off their impressive 2014-2015 season by winning the Midget Tier 4 Provincial Championship.



#### WILDFIRE MANAGEMENT **BRANCH TO OVERSEE CONTROLLED BURNS**

A handful of Peace Region forests are participating in controlled burns over a six-week timeframe.

The project is authorized by the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resources and conducted by the Wildfire Management

The burns are being rolled out in several stages and range between 500 to 2,000 hectares in size, according to the ministry.

"These controlled burns will cover about 10,000 hectares and will help meet wildlife management objectives by improving winter range for ungulates (e.g., moose, deer and elk) and promoting the growth of high-quality forage," writes the ministry. "The introduction of high-intensity prescribed burns in the spring is intended to help restore natural grasslands and early seral habitat."

The forests included in the Peace Region burns are Bear Flat and Wilder Creek, Moberly River, Pine River, and Coldstream Creek.

"These prescribed burns and others may be visible from nearby communities such as Fort St. John. Chetwynd and Hudson's Hope," the ministry warns.

The ministry concludes by assuring that trained wildfire personnel will be monitoring the fires at all times.

The burns begin April 20, 2015 and are expected to continue into June 7, 2015.

#### MEET THE MAYOR

I feel that it is time I made some sort of comment on the progress of Fair Share negotiations. This comment will not get to the depths of negotiating in the press but I think that I owe it to the people of Chetwynd to interpret some of the stuff that other participants in the negotiations have been free to reveal.

As you may know, all the municipalities in the Peace River district, with the exception of Hudson's Hope, were part of a Coalition to establish a united front to protect municipal interests in the ongoing rapid industrial development that is occurring in our region. The concept seemed good and right a year ago but as time moved on some of us became increasingly uneasy with the direction the Coalition appeared to be taking with respect to potential Fair Share negotiations.

Dawson Creek was the first to leave. A few weeks later when it became apparent that Chetwynd's interests were not being served, Chetwynd withdrew. Tumbler Ridge and Pouce Coupe soon followed.

With the Government's call for Fair Share negotiations with a completion date of April 30, 2015, the four South Peace municipalities and Hudson's Hope hired a negotiating team consisting of Blair Lekstrom, Don Lidstone, Municipal Lawyer, and Chris Cvik, Regional District Administrator to represent our common interests. Fort St. John and Taylor elected to remain with the Coalition.

This creates a three-way negotiation. South Peace municipalities and Hudson's Hope have taken the position that we are open to negotiating a settlement that can be acceptable to all parties. We recognize that the Government is in a difficult position both financially and politically. Politically, in the entire north east we are represented by only two MLAs. We are both envied and resented by the rest of the province which sees us as the rich kids who want more.

This, of course is an entirely wrong view. With our Fair Share grant we are still only in the middle of the pack of industrial municipalities with respect to revenues.

The Coalition and the Government have both resorted to negotiation in the press so their positions are well known. The Coalition is demanding that the 2005 MOU be kept intact with its 8.7% compounded-annually increase. (This has brought the total grant to \$46,000,000 for 2015.) The Government put an offer of \$600,000,000 over fifteen years on the table which reduces the annual grant to \$40,000,000 beginning this year.

This is not acceptable to anyone.


The South Peace municipalities with Hudson's Hope have taken the position that, though we are not willing to give away the farm, we are prepared to help ease the political and financial burden of the Government within what we consider reasonable bounds.

I'd better not get into the bad practice of negotiating in the press so this is about all I can tell you at the present. Furthermore, I'm not on the negotiating team. I'll leave that job to the experts.

#### PLANT SCIENCE IS SAVING SOME OF OUR FAVOURITE FOODS

(NC) As long as humans have been growing food we have been dealing with ways to control the pests that eat it before we do. In addition, climate change and global commerce are creating new challenges for farmers. Important crops around the world are under serious siege with crop diseases that threaten the livelihood of thousands of farmers.

In many countries, plant science has become infinitely important as researchers look for ways to prevent certain crops from severe or even irreversible damage, all of which has the potential to devastate economies, as follows:

#### Coffee Rust

Coffee farmers in Central America may lose up to 40 per cent of their crops to a fungus known as coffee rust. This is the same pathogen that wiped out production in Java in the 1800s, crippling the supply to England.

The loss of this crop could impoverish many families and cause a huge rise in coffee prices around the world. Plant scientists, supported by the U.S. Agency for International Development, are working to develop a rust-resistant seed to save the livelihood of thousands of farmers.

#### Citrus Greening in Oranges

A tiny invasive bug is having a huge impact on the orange juice industry in Florida. The Asian citrus psyllid is causing tree roots to deform and fruit to fall prematurely and rot. This slowly kills the tree. The disease has cost the industry \$4.6 billion and thousands of jobs. Now, 500 scientists from 20 different countries are searching for ways to combat the devastating disease.

According to the Washington Post, plant scientists may have found a way to genetically modify the trees, making them resistant to the bacteria. While the industry determines its next steps, plant research continues.

#### Frosty Pod Rot in Chocolate

Everyone who loves chocolate will be horrified to hear that frosty pod rot is devouring the inside and outside of cocoa pods, turning them into a pulpy mass. This disease, which is a massive threat to worldwide cacao production, can cause growers to lose 100 per cent of their groves.

Many growers believe the best way to prevent the pathogen from devastating the entire industry is to invest in bioscience to genetically modify plants so they are resistant to infection.




